## This Week's Opponents:

#### St. Mary's University

The Rattlers, along with MSU-Billings and Incarnate Word, are currently in a three-way race for second place in the Heartland Conference. They are 8-3 in the league and 31-14 overall following a weekend sweep of Oklahoma Panhandle State. The Rattlers defeated the Aggies three times with one of the scheduled four games rained out.

The Rattlers allow fewer than two runs per game, including a total of three runs in the three-game OPSU series. A big reason for that is pitcher Malissa Magee. The three-time Heartland Conference pitcher of the week and reigning conference pitcher of the year had a microscopic 0.68 ERA and an 18-7 record before the OPSU series (OPSU has yet to report game files to the conference for updated stats). Magee averages over a strikeout per inning and opposing hitters are batting just .159 against her.

Offensively, the Rattlers have three players batting over .330. Sarah Cooper leads the team with a .363 average. Kelcy Walker and Lindsay Barnes have provide the biggest offensive punch. Walker has scored a team-high 34 runs, and Barnes has 42 RBIs and 11 home runs.

The Marauders are 15-9 entering a big tournament in St. Paul, MN, this weekend. They've had several games cancelled because of weather in the last two weeks. Mary spoiled MSUB's home opener on March 7, sweeping the double-header behind three home runs from Kaitlyn Richardson. Those have been Richardson's only home runs of the season, but the Marauders have hit 16 as a team. Dre Brunskill is batting over .400, and three other starters are hitting over .320.

#### Week in Review:

The weather gave the Yellowjackets more trouble than did their two opponents last week. Three of six games were cancelled because of wet field conditions, but the Jackets still managed three wins.

Wednesday's doubleheader at University of Great Falls was pushed back to Thursday because of weather. The Yellowjackets held on to win the first-ever game of the series 8-5 before pounding the Argos 17-2 in the second game. UGF is the second four-year university in Montana, after MSU-Billings, to add softball. Yellowjacket freshman Lindsey Trenary from Helena went into the record books as the first winning pitcher in a college softball game between Montana schools. She allowed eight hits and three earned runs in seven innings, striking out five. Terina Stacks, Jenna Haacke, and Mandy Schaapveld each had two hits in the win. In the late game, the Yellowjackets hammered out 15 hits, 13 RBIs, and 17 runs. The 17 runs were a school record. Jenna McCartney and Jessica Frank had three hits apiece. Stacks stole three bases in both games, tying the school record.

Mother Nature wreaked havoc on Billings for the weekend series against Texas-Permian Basin. Saturday's games were cancelled, and the teams were able to get in just one game on Sunday before rain washed out the second game. Trenary went the distance in the 9-1 win, improving to 3-3 on the season. She struck out a career-high seven without issuing a walk. Steph Gosselin went 2-for-3 with a double and a home run. Haacke, Lorel Palmer, and Aysha Maddox also had two hits apiece.

#### Extra Innings:

The race for the Heartland Conference regular season title is all but wrapped up. At 11-1, St. Edward's leads the pack and has only fifthplace Oklahoma Panhandle and sixth-place Lincoln left on the schedule. The next two weeks will determine where MSUB finishes and is seeded for the conference tournament. The race for the No. 2 seed is up in the air between MSUB, STMU, and UIW....It was another good week in the circle for freshman hurler Lindsey Trenary. After seeing little action early in the season, she has been called on frequently in the last month. Along with being the pitcher of record in the first-ever game between Montana colleges last week, she also lowered her ERA to a team-best 2.84....With 34 runs in three games last week, one would think the Jackets pounded extra base hits left and right. But that wasn't the case. In the two wins at Great Falls, totaling 25 runs, 22 of the Jackets' 26 hits were singles. They harried the Argos with 19 stolen bases, setting the top two single-game marks in school history....Senior catcher Aysha Maddox has been steady behind the plate the last two seasons, starting all but two games in two seasons. This year she has had seven multiplehit games, including two last week....Senior Lorel Palmer had the Jackets' longest hitting streak of the season at 14 games earlier in the year. She is currently on a five-game hitting streak as is fellow senior Jenna McCartney.

#### Yellowjacket Softball Staff



Kim Lemmens was hired as the third head softball coach in school history on May 30, 2006. Most recently Lemmens was the first assistant coach at Fort Hays State University in Hays, Kansas. Before her one season at Fort Hays State, Lemmens was the pitching coach at Colorado State University for four years. At CSU, Lemmens helped two pitchers earn All-Mountain West honors. The Rams won two Mountain West titles during Lemmens's four years with the program. Lemmens is originally from Denmark, Wisconsin. She was a pitcher for four years at University of Wisconsin-Whitewater, an NCAA Division III school. She helped Wisconsin-Whitewater to two conference championships and three NCAA Tournament appearances.



Cori Thiermann is in her first season as an assistant coach at MSU-Billings. She is a 2006 graduate of University of Wisconsin-Green Bay where she was a varsity letter winner from 2002 to 2005. Last year she was a student assistant coach at UW-Green Bay. As a senior Thiermann batted .224 in 31 games to help the Phoenix win the Horizon League title and advance to the NCAA Division I Tournament for the first time in school history. UW-Green Bay upset sixth-ranked Oregon State in the first round of that tournament for its first-ever win over a ranked opponent.
