## This Week's Opponents:

University of the Incarnate Word
After advancing all the way to the NCAA South Central Region championship game last season, coach Kevin Jannusch and the Cardinals took on a challenging schedule in 2007. The preseason No. 7 team in the nation, the Cardinals will enter the week with an 18-23 overall record and a 6-6 mark in the conference. They have played seven of the top 10 teams in the most recent NCAA South Central Region poll (\#1 Abilene Christian, \#2 Angelo State, \#3 Central Oklahoma, \#4 Mesa State, \#6 St. Edward's, \#7 St. Mary’s, and \#9 Texas A\&MKingsville). The Cardinals are 2-15 against those regionally ranked teams. Also, all six of their conference losses have been to regionally ranked teams (four to St. Edward's and two to St. Mary's).

Junior Melissa Perez leads the Cardinals offensively and defensively. She was the Heartland Conference preseason player of the year. A two-time HLC first team selection and 2005 conference player of the year, Perez currently leads the league with a .372 batting average and .469 on base percentage. She also ranks in the top 10 in the conference for total hits, doubles, total bases, walks, and slugging percentage. In the circle Perez is 6-14 in 23 appearances. She has struck out 106 in 129 innings.

Allison Britt is the all-time school record holder for stolen bases with 95. She set the school single-season record against the Yellowjackets in San Antonio last year and finished the season with 47 . She is 24 -for-27 this season. Britt, Erin Whitt, Ashley Hinojosa, and Stacy Segner are all batting over .300. Hinojosa leads the team with five home runs and 24 RBIs. Britt has scored a team-high 31 runs.

## Week in Review:

Snow. Snow. Snow. That sums up the Yellowjackets’ last two weeks. MSU-Billings hadn't cancelled a home game since back in 2002, but wintry weather and a lot of snow changed that. Counting last weekend's four-game series against St. Mary's and Tuesday's doubleheader at University of Mary, the Jackets have had nine of their last 10 games cancelled because of weather. The one game they did manage to play against Texas-Permian Basin on April 1 required a considerable amount of work-and drying agent-to make the field playable.

## Extra Innings:

The cancellation of last weekend's games between MSUB and St. Mary’s threw a wrench into the regular season race. The series was a chance for one of the two teams to make a run for second place in the conference standings. By not playing, MSUB is mathematically eliminated from winning the regular season title....St. Edward's is two wins away from clinching the regular season conference title. At 13-1 in league play, the Hilltoppers need just two more wins to mathematically eliminate St. Mary's. SEU plays four games at Lincoln to finish the HLC season....At her current pace of 1.34 hits per game, Terina Stacks still has an outside chance of breaking the single season school record for hits. With 10 regular season games remaining plus the conference tournament, Stacks needs 19 hits to tie and 20 hits to break Cami Rainey's school record of 70. She'll need to have a hot streak and have the Jackets play as many games as possible at the conference tourney. If MSUB had played the nine games that were snowed out in the last two weeks, Stacks would have only had to average 1.0 hits per game over the last three weeks of the regular season to break the record....Stacks is also in a race with Jessica Frank for the stolen bases school record. Both have already eclipsed the old record of six. Frank has swiped 11 bases, and Stacks ran wild on Great Falls two weeks ago to get to $10 . .$. If the weather holds this week, senior Aysha Maddox will break the school record for games played. She is holding on 183. Christy Wankel currently holds the record with 185 games played....Following Saturday's doubleheader with the Cardinals, the Yellowjackets will honor their four seniors: Aysha Maddox, Jenna McCartney, Megan Moeller, and Lorel Palmer. Maddox has been a Yellowjacket for four years. McCartney, Moeller, and Palmer all transferred to MSUB as juniors.

## Yellowjacket Softball Staff



Kim Lemmens was hired as the third head softball coach in school history on May 30, 2006. Most recently Lemmens was the first assistant coach at Fort Hays State University in Hays, Kansas. Before her one season at Fort Hays State, Lemmens was the pitching coach at Colorado State University for four years. At CSU, Lemmens helped two pitchers earn All-Mountain West honors. The Rams won two Mountain West titles during Lemmens's four years with the program. Lemmens is originally from Denmark, Wisconsin. She was a pitcher for four years at University of Wisconsin-Whitewater, an NCAA Division III school. She helped Wisconsin-Whitewater to two conference championships and three NCAA Tournament appearances.

Cori Thiermann is in her first season as an assistant coach at MSU-Billings. She is a 2006 graduate of University of Wisconsin-Green Bay where she was a varsity letter winner from 2002 to 2005. Last year she was a student assistant coach at UW-Green Bay. As a senior Thiermann batted .224 in 31 games to help the Phoenix win the Horizon League title and advance to the NCAA Division I Tournament for the first time in school history. UW-Green Bay upset sixth-ranked Oregon State in the first round of that tournament for its first-ever win over a ranked opponent.
