#### Idaho State University

The Bengals are a first-year NCAA Division I program. ISU reinstated softball as a varsity sport after dropping it in 1983. The Bengals are 6-28 overall and 4-0 at home. They picked up their first win against a Division I opponent last week when they split with Utah Valley State. Chris Shollenberg leads the team with a .292 batting average. Heather Dixon is batting .253 with eight home runs and a .505 slugging percentage. Freshman catcher Shanna Schmitz has batted .230 in 31 games. She was MSUB freshman Lindsey Trenary's battery-mate last year at Helena Capital High School. Lindsay Boughton has logged 121 innings and is 4-16 with a 4.83 ERA.

### Week in Review:

The Yellowjackets finally had good weather last weekend and they made the most of it. After canceling nine of 10 games, the Jackets took advantage of plenty of sunshine to sweep Incarnate Word at Cenex Stadium Friday and Saturday. The four conference wins improved MSUB to 10-5 in the Heartland, locking up the No. 3 seed in the conference tournament.

Senior infielder Jenna McCartney had a Senior Weekend to remember. She batted .636 with a 1.091 slugging percentage in the four games. For Saturday's Senior Day, she went 5-for-5 with two doubles and her first home run of the year. Fellow seniors Megan Moeller and Aysha Maddox also had good weekends. Moeller batted .500 with a home run, and Maddox hit .333. Leslie Davis was 6-for-10 for the weekend with two home runs. Although she only played in two games, Jenna Haacke drove in four runs. The Yellowjackets got four complete games from four different pitchers in the series. Lindsey Trenary and Terina Stacks tossed complete game shutouts. Lisa Moore and Rebakah Tsatsa picked up the other two wins.

### Extra Innings:

St. Edward's clinched the Heartland Conference title with two wins against Lincoln last weekend. They will be the No. 1 seed in the conference tournament April 26-28 in San Antonio. St. Mary's will be the No. 2 seed, and MSU-Billings will be No. 3. Even if Incarnate Word upsets St. Mary's twice this week to create a tie at 10-5 between St. Mary's and MSUB, the Rattlers will have the tiebreaker by virtue of their March 18 win against St. Edward's....Senior Aysha Maddox broke the school record for games played on Saturday. She enters this week having appeared in 187 career games. The previous record holder was Christy Wankel....Terina Stacks took over the lead for the Heartland Conference batting title last week. The sophomore nudged her average up to .379, a single percentage point ahead of teammate Jenna McCartney and two points ahead of Incarnate Word's Melissa Perez, who will miss the rest of the season with a broken arm....As of the April 8 reporting period, sophomore Steph Gosselin ranked 28th in the nation for fewest strikeouts per at bat. She improved that average last weekend, lowering it to just 0.024 strikeouts per at bat....It's now a safe bet that the only single season school record that will fall this year is for stolen bases. Jessica Frank (11) and Stacks (10) are in competition for the record, which each has already broken. For much of the season Stacks was on pace to challenge the school mark for hits in a season, but nine cancellations have put the record out of reach....Sunday marks the return to Cenex Stadium of Joey Ehnes, currently an assistant coach for Great Falls. The Yellowjackets' ace from 2002-2005, Ehnes holds MSUB school records for earned run average, victories, appearances, games started as a pitcher, complete games, innings pitched, strike outs, shutouts, and opponent batting average as well as runs scored.

Kim Lemmens was hired as the third head softball coach in school history on May 30, 2006. Most recently Lemmens was the first assistant coach at Fort Hays State University in Hays, Kansas. Before her one season at Fort Hays State, Lemmens was the pitching coach at Colorado State University for four years. At CSU, Lemmens helped two pitchers earn All-Mountain West honors. The Rams won two Mountain West titles during Lemmens's four years with the program. Lemmens is originally from Denmark, Wisconsin. She was a pitcher for four years at University of Wisconsin-Whitewater, an NCAA Division III school. She helped Wisconsin-Whitewater to two conference championships and three NCAA Tournament appearances.



Cori Thiermann is in her first season as an assistant coach at MSU-Billings. She is a 2006 graduate of University of Wisconsin-Green Bay where she was a varsity letter winner from 2002 to 2005. Last year she was a student assistant coach at UW-Green Bay. As a senior Thiermann batted .224 in 31 games to help the Phoenix win the Horizon League title and advance to the NCAA Division I Tournament for the first time in school history. UW-Green Bay upset sixth-ranked Oregon State in the first round of that tournament for its first-ever win over a ranked opponent.
