Players of the Week (Aug. 29 – Sept. 4)

Hitter: Ali Watson, Montana State - Billings

Outside Hitter, 5-11, Jr. Calgary, Alberta, Canada (Dr. E.P. Scarlet H.S.)

Ali Watson led Montana State – Billings to a 2-2 record at the Days Inn West Denver/Oredigger Classic (hosted by Colorado School of Mines). Watson was named to the all-tournament team for the second-straight tournament. She was the MVP of the Arkansas Tech Invitational last week on route to Heartland Conference hitter of the week honors. Watson had three double-doubles at the Colorado Mines tournament this weekend. Her 23 kills vs. Colorado mines on Friday were a season high and a conference season high in a four-game match. She also recorded a season high for digs this week with 26 against Colo. State – Pueblo. Watson currently leads the Yellowjackets in kills per game (4.80) and digs per game (4.67).

Setter: Natalie Bills, Montana State - Billings

Setter, 5-7, Jr. Provo, Utah (Provo H.S.)

Natalie Bills helped lead Montana State – Billings to a 2-2 record at the Days Inn West Denver/Oredigger Classic (hosted by Colorado School of Mines). She averaged 12 assists per game for the tournament. Bills handed out a season-high 56 assists in a four-game win over Colo. State – Pueblo on Friday. She posted two double-doubles in assists and digs. Against Colo. Mines she had 45 assists and a season high 14 digs. Bills also had seven service aces for the week and currently leads the team with 17 aces in eight games.

On the season, Bills leads the conference in both assists (11.4 assists/pg) and service aces (0.57 aces/pg). This is her second straight week to earn setter of the week honors.

Defense: Katy Migl, St. Mary's

Outside Hitter, 5-8, Sr. San Antonio, Tex. (O'Connor H.S.)

Katy Migl earned all-tournament team honors as the St. Mary's rattlers competed at the AmeriSuites/Mountain Lion Invitational (hosted by Colorado – Colorado Springs. On the week, Migl had 67 digs for a 5.58 digs per game average while adding two kills and two assists. She also had a low 0.07 reception error per attempt average. On the season, Migl leads the Rattlers with 129 digs (4.61).
