Heartland Conference Volleyball Players of the Week (Oct. 3 – Oct. 9)

Hitter: Alicia Cazomier, Montana State - Billings

Middle blocker, 6-0, So. Vauxhall, Alberta, Canada (Vauxhall H.S.)

Alici Cazemier led the raod weary Yellowjackets to a pair of sweeps at Oklahoma Panhandle on Monday and Tuesday. Montana State – Billings – which played four road conference matches in the span of five days—improved its record to 6-2 in the league with sweeps of the Aggies. Cazemier averaged 5.00 kills per game while hitting at a blistering .460 clip. She needed just 50 attempts to total 30 kills in the two matches. Cazemier also had six blocks. For the season she currently ranks second in the Heartland Conference for hitting percentage, third for kills, and first for blocks. Although just a sophomore, the week Cazemier became just the sixth player in school history to eclipse 200 career blocks.

Setter: Courtney Heiser, Western New Mexico

Setter, 5-7, So. Phoenix, Ariz. (Marcos de Niza H.S.)

Courtney Heiser helped guide the Western New Mexico Mustangs to sweep of their competition, all 3-0 victories. She averaged 11.22 assists per game to go along with 22 digs, two blocks and she added six service aces to her conference leading total 56. Heiser came out against Bentley College and recorded her second double-double of the season with 35 assists and 10 digs in the week's first sweep. Heiser and the Mustangs continued their sweeping ways with Saturday wins over Cal State – Dominguez Hills, including 38 assists and 5 digs, and Grand Canyon, adding 28 assists and 7 digs.

Defense: Katy Migl, St. Mary's

Libero, 5-8, Sr. San Antonio, Tex. (O'Connor H.S.)

Katy Migl healped lead the Lady Rattlers to a 2-1 week with split against Lone Star Conference opponents Texas A&M Kingsville and Tarleton State and another conference victory over Dallas Baptist. This is her fourth time to win the Conference weekly defensive award. On the week, Migl recorded 53 digs for a 5.3 digs per game average while adding three service aces, three assists, and one kill. Almost half of her digs came in the win over Dallas Baptist as she logged 26 in the four games She had only two reception errors in 60 attempts for a .02 average during the week. On the season, Migl is tied for second in the Heartland Conference with 4.71 digs per game.
