Heartland Conference Volleyball Players of the Week (Sept. 5 – Sept. 11)

Hitter: Maegan Lowry, St. Mary's

Middle, 6-0, So. Converse, Tex. (Judson H.S.)

Maegan Lowry led St. Mary's to a 4-0 record on the week including a 3-0 sweep of the competition at the Marriott Heartland/Lone Star Challenge in Austin, Tex. Lowry totaled 48 kills in 14 games (3.42 kills/game), including 16 kills in the five-game win over Central Oklahoma, the only school St. Mary's did not sweep 3-0 during the week. She hit .295 on the week with a high of .500 against Texas A&M – Kingsville and .458 against Eastern New Mexico. On the week, Lowry added 21 blocks and 4 digs.

Setter: Courtney Matula, St. Mary's

Setter, 5-8, So. San Antonio, Tex. (Madison H.S.)

Courtney Matula helped lead St. Mary's to a 4-0 record on the week and an overall record of 6-5, back above .500. Matula distributed 172 assists on the week (12.29 assists/game), to go along with 23 digs (1.64 digs/game). In the five-game victory over Central Oklahoma, she put up a double-double with 58 assists and season high 10 digs. The 58 assists were a career high for the sophomore and a conference season high. On the week, Matula added 10 blocks and five service aces, with five blocks and three aces coming against Texas A&M – Kingsville.

Defense: Katy Migl, St. Mary's

Outside Hitter, 5-8, Sr. San Antonio, Tex. (O'Connor H.S.)

Katy Migl joined teammates Lowry and Matula to a sweep of the Heartland Conference volleyball weekly awards and a sweep of the competition at the Marriott Heartland/Lone Star Challenge in Austin, Tex.. This is the second straight week Migl has won the award and she marks the third straight Rattler to garner the defensive award. On the week, Migl recorded 69 digs for a 4.93 digs per game average while adding six service aces, six assists, and two kills. Almost half of her digs came in the win over Central Oklahoma as she logged 32 in the five games She had only four reception errors in 113 attempts for a .035 average during the week. On the season, Migl is third in the conference with 198 digs (4.71).
