### The Week in Review

The Yellowjackets stretched their winning streak to nine matches with three wins last week. They rallied from a 2-0 deficit to defeat Rocky Mountain 3-2 on Tuesday before opening the Heartland Conference schedule with two wins over Dallas Baptist on the weekend.

In Tuesday's cross-town match at Rocky, the Yellowjackets gave the Bears more than a fair shot at an upset, spotting them a 2-0 lead in the match. Uncharacteristically, it was the Yellowjackets' defense that was hurting them. The Bears posted team attack percentages of .298 and .333 in the two wins. Just as quickly as the defense had dug the Jackets into a hole, it pulled them out. Over the final three games of the match, Rocky hit just a combined .011. Jessica Bratton led MSUB with 24 kills on a .315 attack percentage. Ali Watson added 16 kills, and Alicia Cazemier finished with a dozen. Watson and Taylor Faught each picked up double-digit digs. Cazemier and Jessica Lechner were in on six and five blocks respectively, and setter Natalie Bills handed out 52 assists.

The Jackets had little trouble in their Heartland Conference opener against Dallas Baptist on Friday. They hit .327 as a team in the three-game sweep while holding the Patriots to a team attack percentage of .113. Watson led the way with 13 kills and seven digs. Cazemier, Lechner and Bratton each had eight digs.

MSUB had to work a little harder for Saturday's conference win over the Patriots, dropping the second game en route to the 3-1 victory. Cazemier had 16 kills and was in on 10 blocks. Watson had 14 kills and five blocks while Lechner added a dozen kills and five blocks. Bratton finished with 10 kills.

### This Week's Opponent

#### Texas A&M-International

The Dustdevils are new members to the Heartland Conference and provisional members of NCAA Division II. As a provisional member in their first year of reclassification, they are still considered an NAIA opponent.

TAMIU is off to an impressive start to the season at 11-3 overall. The Dustdevils have played a mixed bag of NAIA and NCAA opponents with success against both. Included in their list of victories is a 3-1 upset of NCAA Division I Texas-Pan American. They had a five-match winning streak snapped by Dallas Baptist on September 16 in Dallas and will play one match at Huston-Tillotson on Wednesday before traveling to Billings for the weekend series with the Yellowjackets.

The Dustdevil offense is balanced with three different players averaging over three kills per game. Michelle Castaneda leads the way at 3.55 kpg, followed by Eliza Cezario at 3.37 kpg and Juliana Gusmao at 3.16 kpg. TAMIU's defense has been equal to its offense resulting in a season attack percentage 61 points higher than the opponents'. The Dustdevils feature two prolific blockers at the net with both Nicole Gipson and Cezario averaging at least 1.00 blocks per game. They also have three players—Desiree Arredondo, Gusmao, and Genevieve Trevino—who average over 3.00 digs per game.

## Side Outs

The Yellowjackets' current nine-match winning streak is likely a school record. Volleyball at the school dates back to 1977, but no records are available before the 1984 season. Considering the years for which records exist, the Jackets' nine-straight wins represent the longest winning streak the program has experienced. In fact, in 13 of the previous 22 seasons the Yellowjackets didn't have more than nine wins the entire season....For their 13-3 start, the Yellowjackets were ranked 2nd in the first NCAA Southwest Region poll of the year. It is by far the highest regional ranking in the program's history. The only team ranked higher in the region is Fort Lewis, who the Jackets have split two matches with. The top eight teams in each of the NCAA's eight regions at the end of the year qualify for the NCAA Tournament. Of course, the best way to punch a ticket to the Big Dance is to win the conference tournament, which will be held in Billings on November 3 and 4....Senior Jessica Bratton's magic number is now 92 for tying the career kills record at MSUB. She had another good week last week with double-digit performances in two of the three matches. At her current rate it looks like Bratton may have a chance to break the record during a home match during the second or third week of October....Earlier in the year Bratton became the ninth player in school history to appear in over 300 career games. Senior Alexis Sandru will accomplish that feat on Friday as she enters the weekend with 299 games played....Another school record that will fall sooner than later is the career record for solo blocks. Alicia Cazemier is just two behind Katrina Dahlgren....It's too early to make any judgments on the Heartland Conference race, but there are three teams that seem to be separating themselves from the pack. St. Edward's started the season slow, but is 4-0 in the conference. MSU-Billings is 2-0, and St. Mary's is 2-1. None of the other three teams has a conference win and their combined win total entering the week is 11.
