The Week in Review

The Yellowjackets remained perfect in the Heartland Conference with a pair of wins over St. Edward's University last weekend. The Jackets had to battle for a 30-19, 25-30, 31-29, 30-27 win on Friday night. In Saturday afternoon's match they cruised 30-21, 30-19, 30-18.

Ali Watson posted her fourth 20-20 performance of the season on Friday, knocking down 20 kills to go with 20 digs. Four different Yellowjackets posted double-digit kills. Alicia Cazemier had 16, Jessica Bratton had 13, and Alexis Sandru had 11. Cazemier's 16 kills came on a .500 attack percentage. Natalie Bills handed out 57 assists and added a dozen defensive digs.

The Jackets dominated Saturday's contest, wrapping up the three-game sweep in just an hour and five minutes. Bratton led all players with 17 kills on a .382 attack percentage. Watson had another double-double, her 15th of the season, with 12 kills and 13 digs. Cazemier added 11 kills on a .500 attack percentage. She was also in on six blocks for the second-straight match. Nicole Kruse had a dozen digs. Bills had 33 assists before giving way to Taylor Faught late in the match. Faught handed out a career-high eight assists.

This Week's Opponent

Rocky Mountain College

The Bears will bring a three-match winning streak to Alterowitz on Tuesday. They are 6-3 in their last nine matches. With their 3-1 win against Lewis-Clark State last weekend they improved to 19-6 overall and 6-3 in the Frontier Conference. Rocky had MSU-Billings on the ropes on September 19 at the Fortin Center, building a 2-0 lead in the match before letting the Yellowjackets rally for a 3-2 win. No season stats are available for the Bears.

Oklahoma Panhandle State University

The Aggies are having another tough year, although they have notched their first victories in over three seasons. Winless in the three previous seasons, OPSU will enter the week with a 2-24 record. The Aggies play at Colorado State-Pueblo on Wednesday before traveling to Billings for the weekend series against the Yellowjackets. Three different Aggies average at least 2.50 kills per game. Catherine Clay leads the way at 2.68 kpg followed by Amber McKinney at 2.62 and Val Armstrong at 2.50. Clay leads the team with a .168 attack percentage. Defensively the Aggies are led by Sarah Moran's 4.24 digs per game. That ranks fourth in the Heartland Conference. McKinney ranks eighth in the conference for blocks at 0.75 per game.

Side Outs

The 2006 season is officially on the homestretch, and the MSUB volleyball team is breathing some rare air. The Jackets have never qualified for an NCAA postseason or won a conference championship. They've positioned themselves to do both if they can continue their winning ways over the next few weeks. MSUB is ranked No. 1 in the latest NCAA Southwest Region poll. If that were to hold, the Jackets could host the regional rounds of their first-ever NCAA Tournament....The Jackets' success doesn't date back much farther than the current group of players. The 2006 season will be the third-straight winning season for MSUB, but it will also be just the third winning season in school history. Friday night will be senior night, and MSUB will recognize four key reasons Yellowjacket Volleyball has been put on the map in the past few years: Natalie Bills, Jessica Bratton, Alexis Sandru and Ali Watson....The career achievements of the 2006 seniors have been highlighted here throughout the season. Jessica Bratton will break the school career kills record this week, Natalie Bills will finish No. 2 in school history for career assists, and Alexis Sandru will likely finish in the top five in school history for career digs. Those three have built solid careers over the past four years. Ali Watson wins the prize for having the biggest sudden impact on the program, however. The senior transfer has played just two seasons for the Yellowjackets, and last week she eclipsed 700 career kills and 700 career digs. If the season ended today, she would own the school record for career kills per game average at 4.02....With five matches remaining in the regular season, coach Pa'ulasi Matavao has a career record of 91-96 at MSUB. Conference tournament and NCAA Tournament matches count in a coach's career record, giving Matavao a chance to finish this season with a career record above .500. No coach in school history can make that claim.
