The Week in Review

The Yellowjackets won three times last week to extend their current winning streak to seven matches. They've won 17 of their last 18 with the lone loss during that stretch coming on September 30 at home against Texas A&M-International.

The Jackets started the week with a 3-1 (28-30, 30-18, 30-17, 30-23) win over Rocky Mountain College on Tuesday. On the first point of the match's third game, Jessica Bratton broke Olivia Munro's all-time school record for kills with No. 1,289. She finished the night with 17 kills in the match. Ali Watson had 20 kills and 22 digs, and Alicia Cazemier added 15 kills and four blocks. Jessica Lechner was in on a match-high seven blocks, and Natalie Bills handed out 57 assists as the Jackets hit .317 as a team.

MSUB breezed through Oklahoma Panhandle State on Friday, completing the sweep in just 55 minutes (30-10, 30-14, 30-13). Bratton had 14 kills, and Cazemier added 13 as the Yellowjackets hit .400 as a team. MSUB limited the Aggies to only 12 kills the entire match.

Saturday's win over the Aggies (30-15, 30-22, 30-20) wasn't as quick, but it did provide ample opportunities for the Jackets' younger players to see some action. Watson and Cazemier each led the way with 13 kills. Jill Trabling had a career-high six kills and eight digs. Taylor Faught dished out a career-high 22 assists.

This Week's Opponent

St. Mary's University

The Rattlers are fighting for the No. 2 seed in the Heartland Conference Tournament after slipping a game behind red-hot Dallas Baptist in the conference standings. At 4-3 in the league and 17-13 overall, St. Mary's will be looking to gain some momentum against the Yellowjackets this weekend before next week's Heartland Conference Championship Tournament. St. Mary's has been one of the top teams in the conference for most of the season. The Rattlers started the year 14-6, but have gone 3-7 in their last 10 matches and 1-4 in their last five matches.

Samantha Weber leads the Rattlers and ranks fifth in the Heartland Conference for kills. She also leads the league with a .316 attack percentage and ranks second for blocks. Mallary Moehrig and Sarah Moreno are ranked eighth and tenth respectively in the Heartland for kills per game, and the Rattlers' setter Courtney Matula is second in the league for assists per game. As a team, St. Mary's is in the middle of the Heartland Conference pack statistically. They rank third for hitting percentage, opponent hitting percentage, assists, kills, and service aces.

Side Outs

Tuesday's win over Rocky was important because it was against a cross-town rival. But the wins on Friday and Saturday kept the Yellowjackets perfect in conference play at 8-0 and clinched the No. 1 seed in the Heartland Conference Championship Tournament....Senior outside hitter Jessica Bratton broke Olivia Munro's school record for career kills on Tuesday in the win over Rocky. She finished the week with 1,316 career kills and could have a handful of matches to add to that total if the Yellowjackets qualify for the NCAA Tournament....Speaking of the NCAA Tournament, two weeks ago the Yellowjackets looked like a shoe-in for qualifying for their first NCAA Tournament in the program's history. They were ranked No. 1 in the Southwest Region in the October 11 poll and followed that up with five-straight wins. There was no poll on the 18th, leaving the October 25 poll as the final regular season poll of the year. Unfortunately for the Yellowjackets, their strength of schedule index has jumped up to bite them. Of their five most recent wins, one was against Rocky Mountain, an NAIA opponent that does not help the regional rankings. The other four wins were against NCAA teams with current combined records of 9-47. In this week's NCAA regional poll, the Yellowjackets plummeted all the way from No. 1 to No. 7. Only the top eight teams in the region at the end of the season will be invited to the NCAA Tourney. The winner of next week's Heartland Conference Tournament is guaranteed one of those eight spots in the NCAA's....Through the October 15 ranking period, the Yellowjackets ranked 26th nationally in NCAA Division II for blocks per game at 2.61. A lot of that is due to Alicia Cazemier, who ranked 3rd nationally for blocks per game. Already the school record holder for career solo blocks, Cazemier needs only 22 more total blocks to claim that school record. Natalie Bills is currently ranked 30th in the nation for assists per game.
