# The Week in Review

The Yellowjackets wrapped up two and a half weeks of fall practices this week, and all indications are that they are ready to kick off the 2006 season. The Jackets return all eight players from last year's team that went 20-8 and advanced to the Heartland Conference championship match. Coach Matavao added a recruiting class of four high school players who he expects to contribute as the season progresses. MSU-Billings has been picked by the Heartland coaches to win the conference championship. The Yellowjackets will receive several early season tests while playing at three tournaments in the span of three weeks.

# This Week's Opponents

# Quincy

The Hawks, from Quincy, IL, were 4-20 overall last season and 2-12 in the Great Lakes Valley Conference. They return eight letter winners and six starters. Four of the six returning starters will be seniors this year.

# Fort Lewis

The Skyhawks, from Durango, CO, have been picked to finish third in the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference's west division. Last year they were 13-16 overall and 12-7 in the RMAC. The Skyhawks' top returning player is middle blocker Nicole Schwab, a first team all-conference selection last year and an RMAC preseason all-conference choice this fall.

# **Armstrong Atlantic**

The Pirates, from Savannah, GA, will provide a strong early season test for the Jackets. They were 22-12 last year, winning the Peach Belt Conference title. The Pirates return 12 players from their 2005 championship squad, including all six starters. They have been picked to repeat as PBC championships.

# **UC-Colorado Springs**

The Mountain Lions, the host of this weekend's tourney, have been picked to finish fourth in the RMAC's east division. They were 16-13 overall last year and 12-7 in the RMAC. The Mountain Lions will be a big team, suiting up nine players who stand 5-10 or taller. Four of their top five scorers return from last season, led by junior Diane Sheldon who knocked down 321 kills as a sophomore.
