The Week in Review

The Yellowjackets had a Goldilocks start to the season: not too hot, not too cold. They went 2-2 at the Mountain Lion Invitational at UC-Colorado Springs, splitting matches each day. On Friday, MSUB swept Quincy University, 3-0, before losing to Fort Lewis, 3-1. The Jackets lost to Armstrong Atlantic, 3-1, on Saturday morning before closing out the tournament with a 3-1 win over host UC-Colorado Springs.

For the weekend, senior outside hitter Ali Watson led the Yellowjackets in kills, averaging 4.13 per game. She was also second on the team for digs at 4.33 per game. Watson's best match was an 18-kill, 20-dig performance against UCCS. Alicia Cazemier averaged 3.93 kills and 1.00 blocks per game. She hit .242 for the weekend, good numbers for most players but well below her career average. Jessica Bratton added 3.33 kills per game and was second behind Cazemier with six blocks. Libero Nicole Kruse led all Heartland Conference players for the week with 5.13 digs per game. Setter Natalie Bills had a consistent start to her senior season, averaging 11.6 assists and 3.47 digs per game. Bills was also effective on the attack, knocking down 17 kills on a .342 attack percentage. Senior outside hitter Alexis Sandru didn't get many opportunities on offense—just 59 total attempts—but she contributed on the defensive side of the net with 3.73 digs per game.

This Week's Opponents

Dixie State College

The Rebels are in their first year of competing as a four-year institution after transitioning from a junior college. They are off to a respectable 3-2 start to the season following last weekend's tournament at Westminster College. The Rebels' losses came to Cal Baptist, the defending NAIA national champion, and Albertson College. They defeated Olivet Nazarene and Great Falls before finishing the tournament with their first NCAA II win, a 3-2 victory against Adams State.

Eastern New Mexico University

The Zias will start the week with a 2-2 record after splitting their four matches at the Colorado Christian tournament last weekend. ENMU will host winless Oklahoma Panhandle State on Tuesday before going to the Fort Lewis tourney. Last week the Zias defeated Chadron State and Colorado Christian and lost to Upper Iowa and Western State. Jessie Macknicki is leading the Zias offense, averaging 4.44 kills per game. Randi Egley adds 2.69 kpg.

Seattle Pacific University

The Falcons will probably be the best team the Yellowjackets face during the early season, if not the entire season. Ranked 18th in the nation and off to a 3-1 start, SPU has picked up right where it left off last year. In 2005 the Falcons were 22-6 and went to the NCAA Tournament. They have high expectations again with the return of dangerous outside hitter Alyssa Given, who is averaging 5.38 kills per game and was the GNAC player of the week last week. Before meeting the Jackets at the Fort Lewis tourney, SPU will host Hawaii Pacific and Hawaii-Hilo early this week

Fort Lewis College

The Skyhawks are off to a 5-0 start after winning the Mountain Lion Invitational at Colorado Springs last weekend. Fort Lewis and MSUB will meet for the second time in as many weeks when they square off on Saturday at the Fort Lewis tourney. Fort Lewis defeated the Yellowjackets last Friday, 3-1, at the Colorado Springs tournament. Nicole Schwab averaged 4.72 kills per game to earn Most Valuable Player honors at the tourney. She was also the RMAC player of the week. Adrianne Dettler earned all-tourney honors at UCCS after averaging 4.94 digs per game.

Side Outs

Senior outside hitter Ali Watson and junior middle blocker Alicia Cazemier were each named to the Mountain Lion Invitational all-tournament team. Watson averaged 4.13 kpg and 4.33 kpg while Cazemier tallied 3.93 kpg and 1.00 bpg....Senior outside hitter Jessica Bratton became the third Yellowjacket to eclipse 1,000 career kills at last weekend's tournament. She entered the weekend needing 24 kills to reach 1,000, and she accomplished that on Friday with eight kills against Quincy and 19 against Fort Lewis. With a decent opening weekend, countdown to the school record has begun for Bratton. She needs 17 kills to tie Brandee Sayles for second all-time in school history and 262 to tie Olivia Munro for the school record....It's always tough to gage the early season success of conference opponents when teams are playing in different tournaments across the nation. MSUB and Incarnate Word were picked by the coaches to be the top two teams in the league. They both went 2-2 last weekend. St. Mary's had the best opening weekend with a 3-1 record. The Rattlers, picked third in the preseason coaches' poll, hosted their own tournament last weekend. They defeated Alaska-Anchorage, Colorado Mines, and Valdosta State. Their only loss was a 3-2 setback to Rollins. Aside from the top three teams, how did the rest of the Heartland fare? A combined 1-8 record....Number of the week: 18. That's how many more blocks the Yellowjackets' opponents had at last weekend's tournament. MSU-Billings averaged more kills per game (15.1 to 13.7) than its opponents, but had an attack percentage that was four points lower because of the large disadvantage in blocks.
