### The Week in Review

The Yellowjackets earned some respect at the Fort Lewis tournament last weekend, going 3-1. On Friday they swept both Dixie State and Eastern New Mexico with dominating performances. Against Dixie State, Alicia Cazemier had 16 kills and six blocks. Jessica Bratton and Ali Watson posted 13 and 11 kills respectively. In the win over Eastern New Mexico the Yellowjackets held the Zias to a team attack percentage of .033. Watson had 13 kills, and Cazemier had 11. MSUB's only loss of the weekend came on Saturday when 18th-ranked Seattle Pacific survived a 3-2 scare from the Jackets. Cazemier had 17 kills and seven blocks. Watson finished with 15 kills. The Yellowjackets closed the tournament with a 3-2 upset of previously unbeaten Fort Lewis on the Skyhawks' home court. Bratton and Watson had huge matches with 29 and 28 kills respectively. Natalie Bills matched her career high with 66 assists. Watson, Alexis Sandru, Bills, Nicole Kruse, and Taylor Faught each had over 20 digs in the match.

### This Week's Opponents

#### Central Oklahoma

MSUB couldn't have drawn a much tougher Lone Star opponent to open the Heartland/Lone Star Crossover Tournament. The Bronchos are picked to repeat as the Lone Star North Champions after going 27-8 last year, including a perfect 12-0 in conference play. They are off to a 5-3 start through the first two weekends of action this year. Kelsey Reynolds is averaging a team-best 3.07 kpg and is also second on the team for blocks. Penny Wascovich averages 2.58 kpg on a team-high .376 attack percentage.

#### Texas A&M-Commerce

The Lions were picked to finish sixth in the seven-team Lone Star North Division. They have started the season 3-6 with one of their losses coming to Heartland member Dallas Baptist. Colleen Favaro leads the team in kills at 4.93 per game while hitting at a .300 clip. Wannie Neal adds 3.77 kpg. Favaro and Neal led the team in blocks with 23 and 22 respectively.

#### Southwestern Oklahoma

The Bulldogs were picked to finish last in the Lone Star North Division, and they aren't off to a great start. They enter the week with a 1-8 record with their lone victory coming against Texas-Permian Basin. No Bulldogs average over three kills per game, but four different players are averaging over two kills a game. Kasandra Gurtner leads the way at 2.76 kpg. She also leads the team in blocks at 1.00 per game.

#### Texas-Permian Basin

The Falcons are off to a 1-7 start following a pair of early season tournaments. Their lone win came against Angelo State last weekend at the Angelo State tournament. UTPB is in its first year of reclassifying from NAIA to NCAA Division II, where it will become a member of the Heartland Conference. Matches against the Falcons this year will not count in the conference standings and will still count as a match against an NAIA team. UTPB doesn't start to count as an NCAA opponent until next year. Molly Atnip and Diondra Arenas lead the Falcons in kills. Amber Zant leads the team in digs.

## Side Outs

Senior Jessica Bratton went over 100 kills for the season at last weekend's tournament in Colorado. She entered the season needing 312 kills to catch Olivia Munro for the school career record, so she is approximately 1/3 the way there and the Jackets are approximately 1/3 the way through their regular season schedule. She will need to average about 11 kills per match from this point to catch Munro...Another senior making moves in the career record books is Alexis Sandru. The outside hitter has played a big role defensively this year and climbed from 12th to 7th last week for career digs. She's averaging 3.84 dpg and could make a run at the top five in school history at her current pace....The Jackets' five-game win over Fort Lewis was good for building individual stats, but it was also a big step for the team. Fort Lewis had beaten MSUB 3-1 the previous week and hadn't lost a match prior to the Jackets' 3-2 upset of the Skyhawks on Saturday. Included in FLC's 7-0 start was a win over nationally ranked Seattle Pacific, which edged the Jackets 3-2 last week....MSU-Billings plays six away matches between now and September 22, when the Jackets open Heartland Conference play at home against Dallas Baptist. One of those matches will be in Billings when MSUB plays at Rocky on September 19. Starting with that Rocky match, all but four of the Jackets' remaining contests will be played in the Magic City. If they survive one more week of playing the role of road warriors, the Jackets should be fresh down the stretch....Senior setter Natalie Bills was named the Heartland Conference setter of the week.
