### The Week in Review

The Yellowjackets wrapped up a successful trip South with a pair of 3-0 sweeps of University of Texas-Permian Basin on Monday and Tuesday. The Jackets had gone 3-0 at the Lone Star/Heartland Crossover Tournament the previous Friday and Saturday. Against UTPB on Monday the Yellowjackets hit .224 as a team, winning 30-27, 30-26, 30-27. Setter Natalie Bills handed out 39 assists. Alicia Cazemier shared match-high honors with a dozen kills. Ali Watson and Jessica Bratton posted 10 kills apiece. Nicole Kruse picked up a team-high 18 digs and three service aces. Taylor Faught added 12 digs and Bills had 11.

On Saturday the Yellowjackets survived a 34-32 battle in the first game before cruising to 30-17 and 30-19 wins to close the road trip. Bills dished out 44 assists and the Yellowjackets hit a season-high .361. Watson led all players with 17 kills on a .500 attack percentage. Bratton added 15 kills, and Cazemier finished with 11. No Yellowjacket player had an attack percentage below .230. Kruse and Alexis Sandru had 10 digs each for match-high honors.

### This Week's Opponents

#### Rocky Mountain College

The Bears are 14-3 overall and 8-1 against four-year schools. Some NAIA teams count contests against junior colleges in their overall records. The Bears return 11 players from last year's team that went 13-15 overall and 4-10 in the Frontier Conference. Senior setter Melissa St. John returns after leading the team in assists a year ago. Senior middle blocker Courtney Arthun ranked second in the Frontier Conference for blocks as a junior and was the team offensive MVP two seasons ago. No current season statistics are available for the Bears.

#### Dallas Baptist University

The Patriots are 5-11 overall following their non-conference schedule. Friday's match in Billings will be the Heartland Conference opener for both MSU-Billings and Dallas Baptist. The Patriots, 11-22 last year, are picked to finish fifth in the six-team Heartland Conference. Seniors Jenny Pry and Brandi Moss lead the Patriot offense. The duo ranks fifth and sixth in the conference for kills with Pry averaging 3.38 per game and Moss 3.18. Moss is fourth in the conference for attack percentage at .224 and fifth for blocks at 0.92 per game. Defensively, Ashlee Hawkins leads the Patriots with 3.43 digs per game, currently eighth-best in the Heartland.

## Side Outs

The Yellowjackets probably couldn't be blamed for being a little road-weary after playing the first 13 matches of their 27-match regular season schedule on the road. But after racing out of the gates with a 10-3 mark, the Jackets have to feel pretty good when they look at the remainder of their schedule. Ten of their last 14 matches will be played in Billings as will the Heartland Conference Tournament...Much was made last year of the Jackets' having only eight players on the roster as they marched on to the Heartland Conference championship match. The addition of four players to the roster this season hasn't made much difference. All eight from 2005 returned this season and each has played in all 48 games of the 13 matches thus far while the newcomers have appeared in a combined 14 games...MSUB has built an impressive six-match winning streak dating back to September 2 when they upset Fort Lewis. The Jackets' last loss was at the Fort Lewis tournament to nationally-ranked Seattle Pacific. Even more impressive than the six-match winning streak is the fact that the Yellowjackets haven't lost a game in the last four matches. On September 8 they defeated Central Oklahoma 3-2 then ran off four-straight sweeps...Nearing the midpoint of the season, senior Jessica Bratton has 178 kills and needs 134 more to catch Olivia Munro for the school career record...Bratton was a sophomore teammate of Munro's when Munro broke the school record in 2004...Senior setter Natalie Bills eclipsed 3,000 career assists in last Saturday's win at UTPB...Junior middle blocker Alicia Cazemier keeps inching up the school career record lists. This week she will likely become the seventh player in school history with more than 800 career kills. She has also moved up to the top three all-time at MSUB for solo blocks and total blocks.
