The Week in Review

The Yellowjackets started the week with their best-ever NCAA Regional ranking, debuting at No. 2 in the NCAA Southwest Region poll. They responded with a resounding 3-0 over Texas A&M-International on Friday evening, but lost to the same Dustdevils team 3-1 on Saturday.

Friday's win was the Jackets' tenth in a row. That winning streak was the longest in school history. Ali Watson led all players with a dozen kills and 16 digs. Alexis Sandru, Jessica Bratton, Alicia Cazemier and Jessica Lechner each collected at least five kills in the quick match. MSUB hit .187 as a team while holding the Dustdevils to a .045 attack percentage. TAMIU's rough offensive performance was helped out by an all around defensive effort from the Jackets. Watson, Sandru, Natalie Bills, Bratton, Nicole Kruse and Taylor Faught each had at least five digs. MSUB also had ten total team blocks, with Cazemier in on six.

Saturday's match belonged to the Dustdevils from start to finish. They hit .228 while holding the Yellowjackets to a .127 attack percentage. Four different players reached double-digit kills for TAMIU. For the Jackets, Bratton led the way with 25 kills on a .228 attack percentage. Cazemier added a dozen kills on a .308 attack percentage. She was also in on seven blocks, three solo and four assisted. Besides Bratton and Cazemier, the other eight Yellowjackets who saw action combined for 16 kills and 17 errors for a -.014 attack percentage. The other area the Yellowjackets fell down was in the service game. They managed just three aces, almost a full ace per game below their season average. On the reception they gave up a season-high 13 aces.

This Week's Opponent

University of the Incarnate Word

In the preseason the Cardinals were picked by the Heartland Conference coaches to finish second in the league, but they have not started the season as predicted. After three losses last week, the Cardinals are 4-15 overall and 0-3 in the conference standings. With four of the five teams ahead of them in the standings already halfway through their conference schedules, the Cardinals are in need of league wins if they hope to qualify for the conference tournament.

Offensively, Kim Kvapil and Kari Chapman have accounted for 43 percent of the Cardinals' kills. Kvapil averages 2.39 per game while Chapman averages 2.26. Chapman and Emily Kopecki each have over 20 service aces on the season. Hannah Werchan ranks fourth in the Heartland Conference for digs, averaging 4.13 per game.

Side Outs

Last weekend's stumble against Texas A&M-International may or may not affect the Jackets' regional ranking (the next poll will be released on October 11), but it won't be a factor in the conference race. No matches against provisional members TAMUI and Texas-Permian Basin count in the conference standings. The Yellowjackets still enter this week atop the conference standings at 2-0....Junior middle blocker Alicia Cazemier set a new school record last weekend with her 121st career solo block. She had one on Friday and three on Saturday, including a block for the winning point in the Jackets' game-three win....Senior Jessica Bratton had a solid weekend while the rest of the Yellowjacket offense struggled. Her 25 kills on Saturday, the fourth time she's been over 20 this season, moved her to within 60 of the all-time school record. After this weekend's road matches, the Yellowjackets play five in a row at home between October 13 and 21, leaving good odds that Bratton can break the school record in front of the home crowd....Speaking of the home crowds, they have been pretty good so far this season. Credit a winning team and the "Jacket Junkies," a new student organization on campus that is working on improving student attendance at Yellowjacket games....Along with leading the conference standings, the Yellowjacket lead the conference statistical rankings in seven of eight categories. The only stat for which the Jackets don't currently lead the conference is service aces....Two Yellowjackets rank in the top 30 nationally in the NCAA statistical rankings. As of the September 17 ranking period, Alicia Cazemier ranked 14th nationally for blocks per game and Natalie Bills was 27th for assists per game.
