**Last Week's Highlights:**  
 The Lady Yellowjackets' postseason chances received a big boost last week, followed by two setbacks. They were ranked ninth in the first West Region poll of the season on Wednesday, positioning them for a run at their third straight NCAA Tournament appearance. A pair of regional losses in Washington at the end of the week, however, turned that goal into an uphill battle for the rest of the season.

Last season, one team made the tournament with nine losses, and the Yellowjackets are 10-9 entering the stretch run of the season. Although the games in Florida are not against regional opponents, they could turn out to be valuable if MSUB can win both. Florida Southern in a good team with an 11-6 overall record and 8-1 at home. Nova Southeastern is just 5-12 overall, but has won three of its last four games, including one over Florida Southern.

The Yellowjackets never led in Thursday's game at St. Martin's. They tied the game at 6-6 early in the first half, but were down by double-digits for much of the game. St. Martin's entered the game just one spot behind MSU-Billings in the West Region poll and improved its tournament chances with the win against the Yellowjackets.

The Jackets continued to rely on their top three players. Tanya Petersen scored a game-high 19 rebounds against the Saints, completing the double-double with ten rebounds. It was her second double-double of the season.

Robyn Milne just missed another double-double, scoring eight points and grabbing ten rebounds. She made 4 of 5 from the field, but didn't get to the free throw line in the game.

Jenny Langford added 14 points, making 4 of 7 from 3-point range. She also had a career-high three steals.

The Yellowjackets shot well against St. Martin's—they had their third-best shooting night of the season, connecting on 51 percent of their tries from the field—but the Saints managed 23 more field goal attempts courtesy of 29 Yellowjacket turnovers. The 29 turnovers matched a season high, equaling the Jackets' total at Seattle Pacific in November.

In Friday's game with Northwest Nazarene, the Yellowjackets rallied from a ten point halftime deficit to send the game into overtime. Two Jenny Auer 3-pointers keyed a run in the first ten minutes of the second half that cut the Crusaders' lead to one. Auer finished with 15 points in the game and made two of the Yellowjackets' three 3-pointers in the game.

The Yellowjackets took their first lead of the second half on a Robyn Milne basket with 7:27 to play. There were four ties and three lead changes after that point. Jennifer Skrifvars sank two free throws with 1:17 remaining in regulation to tie the game at 59-59, forcing the eventual overtime.

The teams traded baskets to start the extra period before NNU made four straight free throws to take a four point lead with 1:52 left in the game. Two free throws from Auer and a jumper by Alisa Lordemann tied the game at 65 with 42 seconds on the clock. The Crusaders regained the lead on a jumper with ten seconds remaining, and the Yellowjackets were unable to get off a shot at the end.

Milne tallied her eleventh double-double of the season, scoring 17 points and pulling down 19 rebounds. She also blocked six shots, matching her career high. Petersen added 14 points, and Skrifvars finished with ten.

**Notes:**

\* Robyn Milne is climbing into range of the school career record book for both rebounding and scoring. She has 584 career rebounds, placing her eleventh all time. She needs 24 rebounds to catch Jessie Henigman for the tenth spot in school history. Milne's 249 points this season give her 566 for her career, just 106 short of the program's top 25. At her current pace of 13.1 points per game, she could come close to Joan Langford's 672 by the final game of the season.

\* Sophomore Tanya Petersen continues to improve offensively, and now leads the Yellowjackets in scoring with a 13.3 ppg average. She has scored in double figures for eight straight games dating back to the first Humboldt State game at the end of December.

\* Jenny Langford's 45 three-pointers passes Amy Winslow for eighth in the single season record book. She needs just one more to catch her sister Joan's junior season total of 46 for the seventh highest single season mark. (As a senior, Joan made 62, which is good for the third highest single season total in school history.)

### Lady Yellowjacket Coaches



**Melissa Slone (1<sup>st</sup> year):** Slone joins the Yellowjackets after spending the last five seasons as the head coach at College of Charleston, a Division I school in South Carolina. Slone is a native of Fort Thomas, Kentucky, where she graduated from Highlands High School in 1987. In 1986 she became the school's all-time scoring leader with 1,604 career points before going on to star at Northern Kentucky University, a perennial Division II basketball power. She was a three-year starter at point guard, leading the Norse to an 88-23 record. Northern Kentucky captured three Great Lakes Valley Conference titles and qualified for the NCAA tournament four times in Slone's four years at the school. She graduated in 1991 with a degree in accounting.



**Julie Moehring (1<sup>st</sup> year):** Moehring was formerly an assistant coach at College of Mount St. Joseph, a Division III school in Cincinnati. In addition to her coaching duties, she will also work part time in the Yellowjackets' Marketing and Development Office. Moehring was an NCAA II Kodak All-American for Northern Kentucky in 1987-88 after leading the Norse to their third straight NCAA Tournament. In her junior season, Moehring led NKU to the NCAA II Final Four. At College of Mount St. Joseph last season, Moehring helped the Lions reach their first NCAA Tournament in school history. She coached guards and assisted in recruiting, travel and fundraising.
