This Week's Opponents:

Converse College All-Stars – Converse is a women's college located in Spartanburg, South Carolina. The All-Stars, which are a Division II independent from the NCAA East Region, have won just one game this season and bring a 1-21 record to Billings. Their lone victory came against Montreat College on January 27.

Converse has three players who average double figures for scoring, led by Melissa Bunce's 15.2 points per game. The 6-foot junior also leads the team in rebounds at 8.7 rpg. She has started all 21 games and averages 34 minutes an outing.

The All-Stars are able to put a big frontcourt on the floor with 6-1 Lauren Mueller playing opposite of Bunce. Mueller averages 10.6 points, 7.5 rebounds and 1.3 blocked shots per game.

Melissa Ballard provides the outside scoring punch for the All-Stars, averaging 14.5 points a game. She has made 51 three-pointers in 22 games, knocking down 44 percent of her shots from behind the arc. Ballard led Converse in scoring last season with a 17 ppg average.

The All-Stars have had their difficulties on the defensive end of the floor, allowing an average of 80.8 points per game for a minus-20 scoring margin. They have allowed at least 80 points in ten different games, and over 100 points three times.

Converse has a minus-6 rebounding margin and the All-Stars allow their opponents to shoot 43 percent from the field. They also allow over six made 3-pointers per game.

Lady Yellowjackets on the Airwaves

MSU-Billings will play its final six games of the season at home, beginning with the two games against Converse College this week. The last time the Lady Jackets played six straight home games was during the 1990-91 season.

The Yellowjackets lost last Monday to Florida Southern, who has only been beaten once at home this season. Robyn Milne and Tanya Petersen each notched double-doubles, combining for 30 of MSUB's 55 points and 21 of the Jackets' 39 rebounds.

Petersen scored a game-high 17 points and pulled down 11 rebounds. Milne finished with 13 points and ten boards. Jenny Langford added 11 points, accounting for all three of the team's 3-pointers. The Yellowjackets shot just 20 percent from behind the arc.

On Wednesday, the Yellowjackets' comeback attempt fell just short at Nova Southeastern. After trailing for most of the game, MSUB rallied to take the lead with about ten minutes left in the game. They couldn't hold on down the stretch, however, as the Knights put the game away with late free throws. NSU shot 83 percent from the line on 30 attempts.

Milne recorded her third straight double-double and the thirteenth of the season with a career-high 22 points and 16 rebounds. Milne leads the Yellowjackets for both scoring and rebounding, averaging 13.5 points and 12.2 rebounds a game.

Petersen added a dozen points against the Knights to go with seven rebounds. She is second on the team in both categories, averaging 13.4 points and 6.7 rebounds per game.

For the first time this season, the Yellowjackets didn't make a 3-pointer in a game, missing all 12 of their attempts at Nova.

Notes:

* Robyn Milne's 26 rebounds last week helped her pass former teammate Jessie Henigman for No. 10 in school history for career rebounds. She needs 18 rebounds to catch Shelley Pehlke for No. 9.

* Jenny Langford's 48 three-pointers this season ranks her seventh in school history for 3-pointers in a season. She passed her sister, Joan, last week for the No. 7 spot. Langford's next 3-pointer will tie her with Heather (Reiter) Elkin for No. 10 in school history for career 3-pointers made.

* Following this weekend's game with Converse, the Yellowjackets will wrap up West Region play next week with three home games against Western New Mexico. The Yellowjackets split with the Mustangs in Silver City at the beginning of January.

* The remaining six games on the Lady Jackets schedule will be broadcast live on AM 970 KBUL, and on the internet at www.msubillings.edu/athletics.

Melissa Slone (1st year): Slone joins the Yellowjackets after spending the last five seasons as the head coach at College of Charleston, a Division I school in South Carolina. Slone is a native of Fort Thomas, Kentucky, where she graduated from Highlands High School in 1987. In 1986 she became the school's all-time scoring leader with 1,604 career points before going on to star at Northern Kentucky University, a perennial Division II basketball power. She was a three-year starter at point guard, leading the Norse to an 88-23 record. Northern Kentucky captured three Great Lakes Valley Conference titles and qualified for the NCAA tournament four times in Slone's four years at the school. She graduated in 1991 with a degree in accounting.



Julie Moehring (1st year): Moehring was formerly an assistant coach at College of Mount St. Joseph, a Division III school in Cincinnati. In addition to her coaching duties, she will also work part time in the Yellowjackets' Marketing and Development Office. Moehring was an NCAA II Kodak All-American for Northern Kentucky in 1987-88 after leading the Norse to their third straight NCAA Tournament. In her junior season, Moehring led NKU to the NCAA II Final Four. At College of Mount St. Joseph last season, Moehring helped the Lions reach their first NCAA Tournament in school history. She coached guards and assisted in recruiting, travel and fundraising.
