This Week's Opponents:

Florida Southern College – The Moccasins were last year's Sunshine State Conference champions and qualified for the NCAA Tournament. They were 24-7 overall last year and have been very good in head coach Diane Foli's six years, posting a 123-53 record during that time. The Lady Mocs have qualified for the NCAA Tournament eight times since 1994, including trips to the Big Dance in 2000, 2001 and 2003.

The Lady Mocs were picked to win the SSC title again this year and are off to another good start with a 13-6 overall record. They are 9-1 on their home floor in Lakeland, FL, with their only loss coming back in the middle of December. FSC has won four straight and six of its last seven, with its only loss during that stretch coming at the hands of the Yellowjackets' other opponent this week, Nova Southeastern.

FSC returns its best player from last season, 6-foot junior center Lucresia West. West was the team MVP last season and was also named to the first team all-conference, first team all-SSC tournament, and honorable mention Kodak All-America teams. She was the Sunshine State Conference's player of the week last week after averaging over 27 points and ten rebounds in two wins.

West will present Yellowjacket post players Robyn Milne and Tanya Petersen their biggest challenge of the season. She ranks 11th in the nation for scoring at 20.4 points per game and averages a double-double with 10.1 rebounds a game. She has led the team for scoring in sixteen of their nineteen games. West is shooting just under 64 percent from the field, ranking fifth in the country. She has also blocked 22 shots.

The Moccasins average 71.8 points a game while holding their opponents to just 62.4. While their offense runs through West, they have two players who will shoot the 3-pointer. Meghana Saoji has made 26 of 80, and Brook Kohleim has hit 24 of 80. Rosemary Perry is the only player besides West averaging double figures at 10.2 ppg.

Nova Southeastern University – The Knights haven't been very good for most of the season, but they have been improving in the second half of the year. After starting the season with seven straight losses, NSU has won four of its last six games to improve to 6-13. One of those victories was against Florida Southern. The Knights' record may be misleading because of their schedule. Seven of their 13 losses have been to teams ranked in their regions' respective top ten in last week's regional polls.

The Knights are averaging just 61 points per game for the season, but haven't scored fewer than 61 in their last seven games. Two players average double figures for NSU, led by Jessica Pate's 20.1 ppg. She averages a double-double with 10.4 rebounds a game. Marvelo Washington is adding 16.1 points a game.

The Knights rely primarily on the inside game, having made just 42 three-pointers as a team all season. (The Yellowjackets' Jenny Langford has made 45 by herself this season.)

The Yellowjackets were idle last week. The trip to Florida is their last road trip of the season. They will play their final six games at home beginning February 13 and 14.

MSU-Billings dropped out of the West Region poll last week after beginning the polling season ranked No. 9. Two regional losses in Washington the week before bumped them out. At 10-9, the Jackets may have to win the rest of their games to have a shot at the tournament. The No. 8 seed in last year's regional had nine losses.

- * Robyn Milne has 584 career rebounds, placing her eleventh all time in school history. She needs 24 rebounds to catch Jessie Henigman for the tenth spot. She is also 106 points from reaching the school's all-time top 25.
- * Jenny Langford needs just one more 3-pointer to catch her sister Joan's junior season total of 46 for seventh most in a season.

Melissa Slone (1st year): Slone joins the Yellowjackets after spending the last five seasons as the head coach at College of Charleston, a Division I school in South Carolina. Slone is a native of Fort Thomas, Kentucky, where she graduated from Highlands High School in 1987. In 1986 she became the school's all-time scoring leader with 1,604 career points before going on to star at Northern Kentucky University, a perennial Division II basketball power. She was a three-year starter at point guard, leading the Norse to an 88-23 record. Northern Kentucky captured three Great Lakes Valley Conference titles and qualified for the NCAA tournament four times in Slone's four years at the school. She graduated in 1991 with a degree in accounting.



Julie Moehring (1st year): Moehring was formerly an assistant coach at College of Mount St. Joseph, a Division III school in Cincinnati. In addition to her coaching duties, she will also work part time in the Yellowjackets' Marketing and Development Office. Moehring was an NCAA II Kodak All-American for Northern Kentucky in 1987-88 after leading the Norse to their third straight NCAA Tournament. In her junior season, Moehring led NKU to the NCAA II Final Four. At College of Mount St. Joseph last season, Moehring helped the Lions reach their first NCAA Tournament in school history. She coached guards and assisted in recruiting, travel and fundraising.
