## This Week's Opponents:

Western New Mexico University Mustangs - The Mustangs' season has been very similar to that of the Yellowjackets' with short winning streaks and short losing streaks amounting to roughly a .500 season. Western will bring a $9-10$ overall record to Billings to face the 12-11 Yellowjackets.

The Mustangs have won five of their last eight games, but have only played one game in February, a 79-72 victory against Oklahoma Panhandle. WNMU has played just three times since hosting the Yellowjackets in Silver City at the beginning of January. The two teams split those to games.

The Mustangs' success depends on center Ivanna Stojkovic, who is averaging nearly 19 points and 12 rebounds a game. Of the teams 19 games, she has been the leading scorer 12 times and the leading rebounder in all 19. The Yellowjackets did a good job of holding Stojkovic in check in the first two meetings this year, keeping her to 25 points and 17 rebounds over the two games. The Yellowjackets' top players in the paint, Robyn Milne and Tanya Petersen, combined for nine blocked shots in the two games against the Mustangs with Milne blocking six shots.

Western New Mexico guards Irene Falk and Elyza Schafer each average ten points a game for the Mustangs. Schafer leads the team in both assists and 3-pointers, averaging 3.9 assists and 1.4 made 3 pointers per game. Natalie Lara can also shoot from behind the arc, connecting on 21 of 53 attempts ( 40 percent) in 14 games played.

## Last Week's Highlights:

The Yellowjackets played at home for just the second time in the New Year last weekend, taking two games from Converse College (SC). MSUB will wrap up its season with six straight home games at Alterowitz Gymnasium, beginning with the two games against Converse.

The Jackets' three veterans had big games against the All-Stars. Tanya Petersen ignited a 91 point outing in game one with a careerhigh 26 points on 11 of 17 shooting from the field. She and fellow post player Robyn Milne dominated the interior defense of the AllStars all weekend, combining for 77 points in the two games.

Petersen scored 18 in game two, hitting 7 of 14 from the field. Milne posted games of 17 and 16, missing just eight shots in 23 attempts from the field. She also blocked eight shots in the two games, including five in Saturday's 73-57 win.

Jenny Langford scored her career-high on Saturday, netting 21 points with five 3-pointers. She hit her fifth 3-pointer with just over 12 minutes to play, but took only one attempt after that. The school record for 3-pointers in a game is seven. Langford has made six on two occasions this year and five two other times.

While the big three had good weekends, they weren't the only Yellowjackets with career highs. Lisa Jellum scored a career high 11 points on Saturday, with Jessica Bratton adding a career-high 10 points. Freshmen Shannon Harvey and Jennifer Skrifvars each reached career highs for assists, with Harvey handing out six on Saturday and Skrifvars dishing up five on Friday.

## Notes:

* The Lady Jackets will play their final four games in a span of eight days. Following the three games with Western New Mexico this week, they will host Montana State-Northern next Monday.
* Robyn Milne needs two rebounds to catch Shelley Pehlke for No. 9 in school history for career rebounds.
* Milne is just seven blocked shots short of tying Jessie Henigman's No. 2 mark for blocks in a season.
* Jenny Langford reached the top ten in school history for career 3pointers last week, moving to No. 10 with 77 . She needs ten more to catch Becky Jacobs for No. 9.
* Langford's 55 three-pointers this season rank sixth in school history for a single season. She has a realistic chance to climb all the way to No. 2 in the next four games. Kami Malnaa made 64 in 2001-02. Jenni Winter holds the single season record with 75 threes in 1998-99.

## Lady Yellowjacket Coaches



Melissa Slone (1 ${ }^{\text {st }}$ year): Slone joins the Yellowjackets after spending the last five seasons as the head coach at College of Charleston, a Division I school in South Carolina. Slone is a native of Fort Thomas, Kentucky, where she graduated from Highlands High School in 1987. In 1986 she became the school's all-time scoring leader with 1,604 career points before going on to star at Northern Kentucky University, a perennial Division II basketball power. She was a three-year starter at point guard, leading the Norse to an 88-23 record. Northern Kentucky captured three Great Lakes Valley Conference titles and qualified for the NCAA tournament four times in Slone's four years at the school. She graduated in 1991 with a degree in accounting.


Julie Moehring ( $\mathbf{1}^{\text {st }}$ year): Moehring was formerly an assistant coach at College of Mount St. Joseph, a Division III school in Cincinnati. In addition to her coaching duties, she will also work part time in the Yellowjackets' Marketing and Development Office. Moehring was an NCAA II Kodak All-American for Northern Kentucky in 1987-88 after leading the Norse to their third straight NCAA Tournament. In her junior season, Moehring led NKU to the NCAA II Final Four. At College of Mount St. Joseph last season, Moehring helped the Lions reach their first NCAA Tournament in school history. She coached guards and assisted in recruiting, travel and fundraising.
