## Last Week's Highlights:

The Lady Yellowjackets finished the 2003-2004 regular season with a six game winning streak. MSUB downed West Region rival Western New Mexico three times last week in Billings, then wrapped up the season on Monday with an eight point win over NAIA Montana StateNorthern.

The result of that six game winning streak was better than most Yellowjacket fans could have hoped for. On Wednesday, MSUBillings moved back into the NCAA West Region poll at No. 9. The top eight teams in the final poll of the season qualify for the NCAA Tournament.

The Yellowjackets have a 16-11 overall record. Most of the teams in the region still have three or four games remaining on their schedules, so the Jackets will watch over the next eleven days as the bottom six teams in the poll battle for a postseason berth.

All four of the Yellowjackets' wins over the past week were important, with any loss along the way most likely ending any postseason chances. The three game sweep of Western New Mexico gave MSUB a 10-7 record against regional teams with six of the victories coming on the road.

Tanya Petersen, Robyn Milne and Jenny Langford each averaged double figures for scoring in the final four games of the season. Petersen scored 80 points for a 20 points per game average. She also averaged 9.3 rebounds a game for the week and blocked six shots. Petersen finished the regular season as the Yellowjackets' leading scorer and second-leading rebounder, averaging 15.0 points and 7.1 boards a game.

Milne continued her steady play by averaging 17.8 points, 10.5 rebounds and 3.8 blocked shots per game in the final four games. For the season, she averaged 14.4 points, 11.6 rebounds and 2.7 blocks a game. She posted fourteen double-doubles in 27 games. Milne and Petersen were the only two Jackets to start all 27 games.

## Lady Yellowjackets on the Airwaves

Langford averaged 12.3 points per game last week, making thirteen 3pointers. She knocked down a career-high six triples in the win over MSU-Northern and continued to climb in the school career record book for 3-point shooting. (See shaded box to the left to see where the 2003-2004 Yellowjackets rank in the school record books.)

Freshman Shannon Harvey played well above her averages during the final four games. She scored 8.8 points per game while leading the team in assists at 6.5 per game. For the season, Harvey averaged 3.8 points and 2.3 assists per game. Of her sixteen 3-pointers this season, seven came in the final four games, as did 26 of her 58 assists.

Along with Harvey's stepping up to help keep the Jackets' tournament hopes alive, fellow freshman guard Jennifer Skrifvars also took advantage of increased playing time. She averaged 4.3 points, 4.3 rebounds and 3.8 assists per game over the final four games.

## Notes:

* While the Yellowjackets are not assured of a spot in the tournament, they will continue to practice over the next two weeks. With the No. 9 ranking in this week's poll, the Jackets could easily move into the top eight should a couple other teams in the poll lose over the final two weekends.
* The next regular season West Region poll will be released on Wednesday, March 3. That will be the final poll of the regular season, but it doesn't always reflect who is chosen for the tournament. The tournament seeding poll is released at 8:30 p.m. MST on Sunday, March 7.
* If the Yellowjackets do make the tournament, they will likely be traveling to Seattle. Top-ranked Seattle Pacific is the only unbeaten team in the nation and is ranked first in both the regional and national polls.
* The results of the March 7 poll and tournament seeding will be posted on the Yellowjackets' website (www.msubillings.edu/athletics) shortly after the announcement from the NCAA.

## Lady Yellowjacket Coaches



Melissa Slone (1 ${ }^{\text {st }}$ year): Slone joins the Yellowjackets after spending the last five seasons as the head coach at College of Charleston, a Division I school in South Carolina. Slone is a native of Fort Thomas, Kentucky, where she graduated from Highlands High School in 1987. In 1986 she became the school's all-time scoring leader with 1,604 career points before going on to star at Northern Kentucky University, a perennial Division II basketball power. She was a three-year starter at point guard, leading the Norse to an $88-23$ record. Northern Kentucky captured three Great Lakes Valley Conference titles and qualified for the NCAA tournament four times in Slone's four years at the school. She graduated in 1991 with a degree in accounting.


Julie Moehring ( $\mathbf{1}^{\text {st }}$ year): Moehring was formerly an assistant coach at College of Mount St. Joseph, a Division III school in Cincinnati. In addition to her coaching duties, she will also work part time in the Yellowjackets' Marketing and Development Office. Moehring was an NCAA II Kodak All-American for Northern Kentucky in 1987-88 after leading the Norse to their third straight NCAA Tournament. In her junior season, Moehring led NKU to the NCAA II Final Four. At College of Mount St. Joseph last season, Moehring helped the Lions reach their first NCAA Tournament in school history. She coached guards and assisted in recruiting, travel and fundraising.
