This Week's Opponents:

<u>Rocky Mountain College Bears</u> – After starting the season 3-0, the Battlin' Bears are 6-4 after losing at South Dakota Tech last weekend. Amber Griffith (5-10 Sr.) leads RMC with 18.5 points per game through the first ten games.

Katherine Bitz (5-10 So.) is averaging 15 ppg after dropping in 26 in a win over Valley City State. She was 4-of-7 from 3-point range and sent the game into overtime with a last-second 3-pointer. Mandy Norby (6-1 Fr.) is averaging over ten points a game. Rocky has given up 72.3 ppg while scoring 68.9.

<u>University of Montana Grizzlies</u> – The Lady Griz started the year 3-0 with a victory over Montana-Western and two big wins at the Wahine Classic in Honolulu. Montana will face No. 2 Texas in the tournament's championship game Sunday night and enter the game against MSUB either 4-0 or 3-1. If ever the Lady Griz could overlook the Jackets, it might be four days after facing the second-ranked Longhorns and then traveling back to Missoula from Honolulu.

Julie Deming (5-10 Sr.) scored a career-high 18 points against Hartford in the tournament's semifinals. Hollie Tyler (6-3 Jr.) added 16.

Tyler also scored a game-high 16 points in UM's first round win over Syracuse. Through the first three games of the year Tyler is averaging 12.7 points and six rebounds a game. Deming is averaging a team-high 16.3 ppg while playing just over 26 minutes a game. The Grizzlies will have a depth advantage over the Jackets as they have nine players averaging over ten minutes a game.

Defense has been the key to Montana's 3-0 start. The Lady Griz are giving up just 48.3 points per game entering Sunday's Wahine Classic Championship game against Texas. UM held Hartford to just 49 points and Montana-Western to 41. The Yellowjackets have won the last seven meetings between the cross-town rivals, including last year's ten point win on Rocky's home court. The Yellowjackets have won 12 of the last 13 meetings and 23 of the last 25. The last MSUB loss was January 9, 1995 at Rocky (58-62).

Robyn Milne scored a career-high 16 against the Bears last year with nine rebounds and three blocked shots. The Yellowjackets are 29-4 all time at Alterowitz against Rocky. The last time the Jackets lost at home to the Bears was February 20, 1980 (54-60).

The Yellowjackets have lost the last twelve meetings with the Lady Griz dating back to 1980. The last time the Jackets won was when they were Eastern Montana College in 1979.

Last season the Griz cruised to a 68-52 win at Dahlberg Arena. Tyler had a double-double with 16 points and 10 rebounds. Milne had 11 rebounds and four blocked shots for MSUB. In the three meetings since 1998, Montana has won by an average score of 73.3 to 53.7.

Last Week's Results:

None. The Lady Yellowjackets' last game was a 66-42 loss at Seattle Pacific on Nov. 22.

Notes:

After Monday's game against Rocky Mountain, the Yellowjackets won't play in Billings again until January 16 and 17 when they host Green Mountain (VT). Included in that ten-game road swing will be DI games at Montana and Wyoming as well as West Region contests against Western Washington, Alaska-Anchorage, Alaska-Fairbanks, Central Washington, Humboldt State and Western New Mexico.

Lady Yellowjacket Coaches

Melissa Slone (1st year): Slone joins the Yellowjackets after spending the last five seasons as the head coach at College of Charleston, a Division I school in South Carolina. Slone is a native of Fort Thomas, Kentucky, where she graduated from Highlands High School in 1987. In 1986 she became the school's all-time scoring leader with 1,604 career points before going on to star at Northern Kentucky University, a perennial Division II basketball power. She was a three-year starter at point guard, leading the Norse to an 88-23 record. Northern Kentucky captured three Great Lakes Valley Conference titles and qualified for the NCAA tournament four times in Slone's four years at the school. She graduated in 1991 with a degree in accounting.

Julie Moehring (1st year): Moehring was formerly an assistant coach at College of Mount St. Joseph, a Division III school in Cincinnati. In addition to her coaching duties, she will also work part time in the Yellowjackets' Marketing and Development Office. Moehring was an NCAA II Kodak All-American for Northern Kentucky in 1987-88 after leading the Norse to their third straight NCAA Tournament. In her junior season, Moehring led NKU to the NCAA II Final Four. At College of Mount St. Joseph last season, Moehring helped the Lions reach their first NCAA Tournament in school history. She coached guards and assisted in recruiting, travel and fundraising.
