This Week's Schedule:

Friday, Dec. 19 - at Alaska-Anchorage Saturday, Dec. 20 – vs. Alaska Fairbanks (at Anchorage)

This Week's Opponent:

University of Alaska-Anchorage Seawolves - The Seawolves are 4-2 after winning their first four games of the season. They have dropped back to back games to Humboldt State and Western Oregon. Before facing MSUB Friday at the Glacier Classic, UAA will play host to Western New Mexico on Wednesday.

Kami Massey (5-10 Sr., Payson, UT) leads the Seawolves in scoring at 14.7 ppg. Four different players average double figures. Tanya Nizich is averaging 2.3 3-pointers per game and is third in school history for career 3-pointers made. Fourteen of her 19 made field goals this year have been from behind the arc.

University of Alaska-Fairbanks Nanooks - The Nanooks were picked to finish last in the Great Northwest Athletic Conference by the league's coaches, but have started the season 5-1. Their only loss was to Army at the end of November. Although the Nanooks won't be leaving Alaska for the games at the Glacier Classic, they will be playing for the first time this season away from Fairbanks.

Four players are averaging double-digits for UAF, led by Cody Burgess (5-10 Sr., Leavenworth, WA) who is scoring 19.3 ppg. She also leads the team in rebounding at 8.0 rpg. Cecilia Chan (5-4 Sr., Toronto, ON) is averaging 14.2 ppg. Chan has made twenty 3pointers this season and the Nanooks are averaging 8.3 threes a game as a team. Forty-two percent of UAF's field goal attempts have been from 3-point range (compared to 27-percent of the Yellowjackets').

Last Week's Results: MSUB 51, Wyoming 62 MSUB 57, Western Washington 66

Last Week's Highlights:

The Lady Jackets continued to play improved offensively and defensively in terms of mastering coach Slone's system, but were again done in by turnovers and poor shooting. Against their second Division I opponent in as many weeks, the Yellowjackets turned the ball over 28 times and shot just 36-percent from the field at the Wyoming Shootout.

The 28 MSU-Billings turnovers led to 29 Cowgirls points in a game that the Yellowjackets lost by 11. Fifteen of those turnovers came in the first half, leading to a 21-5 advantage for Wyoming in points off turnovers in the first half alone.

Tanya Petersen led all Yellowjacket scorers with 13 points. Sophia Forney again showed flashes of being an explosive scorer, finishing with 10 points. The freshman swing player is connecting on 48percent of her field goal attempts and is converting at a 77-percent clip at the free throw line this season.

Robyn Milne netted nine points to go with a game-high 11 rebounds against Wyoming. It was just the third time in seven games that she hasn't finished with a double-double and the second time she has missed a double-double with nine points.

Against Western Washington, the Jackets led by three at halftime and were tied with the Vikings late in the game. WWU hit 3-of-4 field goals and 6-of-7 free throws in the final 3:36 to seal the win.

Jenny Langford came within one 3-pointer of tying the school single-game record. She was 6-of-8 from behind the arc, providing an outside scoring punch that MSUB has lacked in the past few games. The school record for 3-pointers in a game is seven, set by Amy Winslow in 1997 and tied by Jenni Winter in 1998.

Milne notched her fifth double-double with 17 points and 12 rebounds. She leads the Lady Jackets at 12.8 points and 12.5 rebounds a game.

Petersen scored 13 points for the second game in a row at Western Washington, upping her season average to 9.9 ppg. She is second on the team for rebounds, averaging 6.4 per game. She also handed out a career-high eight assists.

The Yellowjackets outscored the Vikings by 15 points from 3-point range, but made three fewer field goals all together and eight fewer free throws. MSUB found its way to the free throw line just ten times in the game and twice in the second half, connecting on 6-of-10 from the charity stripe. Western was 14-of-23 from the line.

Other than dropping the Lady Yellowjackets below the .500 mark for the first time since December 2, 2000, the losses to Montana and Wyoming over the past two weeks shouldn't hurt much when it comes time for regional seeding. MSU-Billings will earn seven points in the regional power poll for each of the DI losses, exactly the same number of points they will get for defeating any NAIA team.

Whether or not the Lady Jackets make the NCAA Tournament for the third straight year will likely be determined in the eight-straight road games against West Region opponents, beginning with the loss at Western Washington on Monday and ending January 10 at Western New Mexico. After that road swing, MSU-Billings will have just five West Region games remaining (they are currently 2-3 in the region). Those who follow Division II basketball closely know that a team's in-region record is the No. 1 factor in earning an NCAA Tournament berth. If the Lady Jackets can find a way to win five or six of those West Region road games in December and January, they could still land themselves in the tournament mix come March.

The last time MSUB lost three games in a row was during the 2000-01 season, when they did it twice. The last time the Lady Jackets lost four straight in the same season was 1991-92.

Lady Yellowjacket Coaches

Melissa Slone (1st year): Slone joins the Yellowjackets after spending the last five seasons as the head coach at College of Charleston, a Division I school in South Carolina. Slone is a native of Fort Thomas, Kentucky, where she graduated from Highlands High School in 1987. In 1986 she became the school's all-time scoring leader with 1,604 career points before going on to star at Northern Kentucky University, a perennial Division II basketball power. She was a three-year starter at point guard, leading the Norse to an 88-23 record. Northern Kentucky captured three Great Lakes Valley Conference titles and qualified for the NCAA tournament four times in Slone's four years at the school. She graduated in 1991 with a degree in accounting.

Julie Moehring (1st year): Moehring was formerly an assistant coach at College of Mount St. Joseph, a Division III school in Cincinnati. In addition to her coaching duties, she will also work part time in the Yellowjackets' Marketing and Development Office. Moehring was an NCAA II Kodak All-American for Northern Kentucky in 1987-88 after leading the Norse to their third straight NCAA Tournament. In her junior season, Moehring led NKU to the NCAA II Final Four. At College of Mount St. Joseph last season, Moehring helped the Lions reach their first NCAA Tournament in school history. She coached guards and assisted in recruiting, travel and fundraising.
