This Week's Opponents:

<u>Central Washington University Wildcats</u> – The Lady Jackets' West Region rivals are 4-2 since losing to MSUB on November 21 at the Seattle Pacific tournament. Freshman Sophia Forney hit a pair of free throws with 2.5 seconds left in the game to lift the Yellowjackets over the Wildcats in their first meeting this season.

Central Washington enters the UC-San Diego Classic with a 5-3 overall record following a 90-47 win over Willamette on Dec. 20. The Wildcats' only loss in their last five games was at ninth-ranked Seattle Pacific on Dec. 4. SPU is the only common opponent of the Jackets and Wildcats this season, with the unbeaten Falcons winning against each.

Four Wildcats average double figures and CWU is scoring 75.1 points per game as a team. Laura Wright (6-3 Fr., Longview, WA) and Angela Jensen (5-7 Sr., Bellingham, WA) both average just over 14 points a game, ranking them No. 6 and No. 10 respectively in the Great Northwest Athletic Conference for scoring.

Loni Ainslie (5-7 Jr., Graham, WA) and Lindsay Weiss (5-9 Sr., Goldendale, WA) each average ten and a half points a game, helping the Wildcats outscore their opponents by an average of 9.1 points per game. Ainslie, Weiss and Jensen have combined for 38 of the Wildcats' 55 3-pointers. CWU averages 6.9 threes a game.

<u>Humboldt State University Lumberjacks</u> – The Lumberjacks started the season with three wins in their first four games, but have lost four straight to fall to 3-5 overall. The last time Humboldt won was Dec. 4 when they downed Alaska-Anchorage, 54-53, in Anchorage. That was followed by losses to Alaska-Fairbanks, Oregon Tech, Chico State and Sonoma State.

Anchorage and Fairbanks are the only common opponents between the Yellowjackets and Lumberjacks. MSUB defeated both UAA and UAF at the Glacier Classic in their last action before the holiday break.

Humboldt averages just 54.4 points per game and has only one player averaging double figures. Nicole Lynch (6-2 Jr., Danville, CA) is scoring 14.6 points per game, tied for sixth in the GNAC. The Jacks' next leading scorer is Peni Vaefaga (5-6 Sr., Sacramento, CA), who

Melissa Slone (1st year): Slone joins the Yellowjackets after spending the last five seasons as the head coach at College of Charleston, a Division I school in South Carolina. Slone is a native of Fort Thomas, Kentucky, where she graduated from Highlands High School in 1987. In 1986 she became the school's all-time scoring leader with 1,604 career points before going on to star at Northern Kentucky University, a perennial Division II basketball power. She was a three-year starter at point guard, leading the Norse to an 88-23 record. Northern Kentucky captured three Great Lakes Valley Conference titles and qualified for the NCAA tournament four times in Slone's four years at the school. She graduated in 1991 with a degree in accounting.



Julie Moehring (1st year): Moehring was formerly an assistant coach at College of Mount St. Joseph, a Division III school in Cincinnati. In addition to her coaching duties, she will also work part time in the Yellowjackets' Marketing and Development Office. Moehring was an NCAA II Kodak All-American for Northern Kentucky in 1987-88 after leading the Norse to their third straight NCAA Tournament. In her junior season, Moehring led NKU to the NCAA II Final Four. At College of Mount St. Joseph last season, Moehring helped the Lions reach their first NCAA Tournament in school history. She coached guards and assisted in recruiting, travel and fundraising.
