## Lady Yellowjacket Basketball 2003-2004

#### This Week's Opponent:

Green Mountain College Eagles – Entering this week, the Eagles are 0-for-the season. They have lost ten straight games to start the year under second-year coach Megan Chawansky. Chawansky guided Green Mountain to a 7-17 record in her first season last year, but has just three players returning from that team.

Green Mountain is a former NAIA school reclassifying to NCAA Division II. Located in Poultney, VT, they are currently playing as a DII independent.

Through the first ten games, the Eagles are averaging 51.9 points per game while allowing 78.9. No other statitistics were available from Green Mountain.

### Last Week's Highlights:

The Lady Yellowjackets split a pair of games at Western New Mexico over the weekend, winning easily on Friday and losing on free throws Saturday.

Friday's victory gave MSU-Billings its first three game winning streak of the season. Behind their second best shooting performance of the year, the Lady Jackets built a 22-point lead in the second half and cruised to the win. MSUB shot 51-percent from the field, eclipsing the 50-percent mark for just the second time this season.

Eight different players scored for the Jackets in the winning effort, led by 13 apiece from Tanya Petersen and Jenny Langford. Shannon Harvey added 11 points, and Jenny Auer finished with 10 points and a season-high five assists.

Robyn Milne added nine points with eight rebounds and four blocked shots. She was a perfect 3-of-3 from the field and 3-of-3 from the line while shutting down WNMU's top player inside. The Yellowjacket defense didn't allow a double figure scorer and held the Mustangs to just 31-percent shooting from the field.

In Saturday's loss, the Jackets' hot shooting from the night before turned cold. They shot 38-percent from the field and just 29percent from 3-point range. The Yellowjackets held Western to 32percent shooting from the field, but their 26 turnovers and 16 fouls compounded the problems of their own shooting.

Even though the Yellowjackets made two more field goals than the Mustangs, Western New Mexico outscored MSU-Billings 23-12 at the free throw line. Despite the poor offensive night, the Yellowjackets were still in the game until the final minutes.

The game was tied at 53-53 with 1:54 remaining, but neither team scored another field goal in the game. Western New Mexico made six free throws in the last two minutes of the game to pull away for the win.

Petersen led all scorers with 21 points, connecting on 8-of-14 from the field. She was also a perfect 5-of-5 from the free throw line, adding eight rebounds and three blocked shots to her stat line. The 21 points matched Petersen's career-high.

Milne and Langford scored 12 and 11 points respectively, but the remaining Yellowjackets combined for just nine points. Petersen, Milne and Langford were a combined 17-of-37 from the field (46percent) while the rest of the Jackets were a combined 3-of-16 (19percent). Milne also grabbed a game-high 14 rebounds for her ninth double-double of the season.

#### **Notes:**

- \* The Yellowjackets wrapped up a ten game road stretch at Western New Mexico, finishing those ten games with a 5-5 record. Two of the losses were to Division I teams (Montana and Wyoming).
- \* Eight of the Lady Jackets' final twelve games will be played at Alterowitz Gymnasium, including the final six games of the season. The last time MSU-Billings played six straight home games was the 1990-91 season.
- \* Despite the ten straight road games, the Yellowjackets only have one fewer home game than they had when they were last a member of the PacWest Conference in 2000-2001.
- \* Robyn Milne is ranked in the NCAA's top 50 in two statistical categories through the games of January 4. She is third in the nation for rebounds per game (12.3) and 21st in the country for blocked shots per game (2.2).
- \* Jenny Langford is also ranked in the nation's top 50 after the year's first statistical rankings. She is 39<sup>th</sup> for 3-pointers made per game (2.4) and 45<sup>th</sup> for 3-point field goal percentage (41.3). Updated statistical rankings are posted each week on the NCAA website (www.ncaa.org).

## **Lady Yellowjacket Coaches**



**Melissa Slone (1<sup>st</sup> year):** Slone joins the Yellowjackets after spending the last five seasons as the head coach at College of Charleston, a Division I school in South Carolina. Slone is a native of Fort Thomas, Kentucky, where she graduated from Highlands High School in 1987. In 1986 she became the school's all-time scoring leader with 1,604 career points before going on to star at Northern Kentucky University, a perennial Division II basketball power. She was a three-year starter at point guard, leading the Norse to an 88-23 record. Northern Kentucky captured three Great Lakes Valley Conference titles and qualified for the NCAA tournament four times in Slone's four years at the school. She graduated in 1991 with a degree in accounting.



Julie Moehring (1<sup>st</sup> year): Moehring was formerly an assistant coach at College of Mount St. Joseph, a Division III school in Cincinnati. In addition to her coaching duties, she will also work part time in the Yellowjackets' Marketing and Development Office. Moehring was an NCAA II Kodak All-American for Northern Kentucky in 1987-88 after leading the Norse to their third straight NCAA Tournament. In her junior season, Moehring led NKU to the NCAA II Final Four. At College of Mount St. Joseph last season, Moehring helped the Lions reach their first NCAA Tournament in school history. She coached guards and assisted in recruiting, travel and fundraising.
