This Week's Schedule: November 20 vs. Western Washington

This Week's Opponents:

<u>Western Washington University Vikings</u> – Saturday's game in Billings will be the season-opener for the Vikings. They have played five exhibition games. They defeated Trinity Western British Columbia, 75-69, and British Columbia, 76-75, before losing to Simon Fraser, 73-58, in a three-game trip to Canada. The Vikings finished the exhibition season with two games at home, losing to Simon Fraser, 56-55, and trouncing Capilano College, 72-44.

Western Washington has been one of the West Region's top powers for a number of years. The Vikings have qualified for the last seven NCAA Tournaments, including a Final Four appearance in 1999-2000. Western was 21-8 last year, with a first round win in the NCAA Tournament. It was the seventh-straight 20-win season for the Vikings.

Head coach Carmen Dolfo returns to the bench in 2004 after a year on sabbatical. Interim head coach Sara Nichols will reassume her duties as the team's top assistant. Dolfo has built a 278-105 career record at Western for an impressive .726 winning percentage.

The Vikings return three starters from last season's tournament team. Guard Jodi Gerald is the team's only senior. She averaged 11.1 points and 5.1 rebounds a game in 2003-2004. In the final 14 games of the season, Gerald averaged 15.4 points.

The other two returning starters are both juniors. Forward Tina Donahue averaged 10.1 points and 4.0 rebounds last season. Guard Samantha Hubbard averaged 3.6 points and 3.4 assists.

The Vikings expect to get immediate help from transfer center Courtney Clapp. The junior averaged 20 points and 7.5 rebounds a game last year at Santa Rosa Junior College.

Last Week's Highlights:

The MSU-Billings women's basketball team exhibited an efficient balance in the Lady Jackets' annual Blue-Gold Scrimmage on Saturday. The Blue team prevailed 70-64 in the mixed squad game.

The Lady Jackets used a balanced inside/outside offensive attack to shoot 44 percent from the field and 47 percent from 3-point range. Junior guard Kayla Frize (Miles City, MT) looked strong in her first action in nearly a year. After missing the past two seasons because of a knee injury, Frize scored 20 points Saturday night, connecting on all five of her 3-point attempts.

Transfer forward Michelle Lieber (So., Gillette, WY) also netted 20 points in the game, shooting 10-of-12 from the field. She finished with a double-double, grabbing 11 rebounds. Senior center Robyn Milne (Richey, MT) also notched a double-double with 19 points and 12 boards. She added four blocked shots.

Junior guard Jenny Langford (Reedpoint, MT) joined Frize with a solid night from behind the arc. Langford connected on 5-of-10 from 3-point range, finishing with 15 points and four assists. Langford enters the season ranked ninth in school history for career 3-pointers.

In all, eight players scored in double figures. Jennifer Skrifvars (So., Brea, CA) scored 10 points; Tanya Petersen (Jr., Billings, MT) finished with 14 points; Sami Walking Bear (Jr., Billings, MT) added 10 points; and Shannon Harvey (So., Billings, MT) netted 12 points.

Notes:

- Saturday's game against Western Washington will be the first of 15 home dates for the Lady Yellowjackets in 2004-2005. MSU-Billings will have one of its most balanced schedules in the past several years with three home games in November, four home games in December, five home games in January, and three home games in February.
- Seven of the Jackets' 15 home games will be against West Region opponents. Beginning with Western Washington this weekend, Humboldt State, St. Martin's, Western New Mexico, Western Oregon and Grand Canyon will make trips to Billings.
- Yellowjacket head coach Kevin Woodin will tip off his collegiate head coaching career on Saturday against the Vikings. Woodin was a 10-year veteran high school coach with two State AA championships to his credit at Billings West High School.
- Forward Jessica Bratton rejoins the team this week after completing the volleyball season. She finished her sophomore campaign as one of the top hitters in the PacWest Conference.

2004-2005 Lady Yellowjacket Coaches

Kevin Woodin (1st year): Woodin takes over the Yellowjackets after a very successful career as the head coach at Billings West High School. He guided the Lady Bears to back-to-back State AA Championships in his final two seasons, including an unbeaten record last year. In ten seasons at West High, Woodin was a combined 138-81 for a .610 winning percentage. He was a two-time Montana Coach of the Year and a finalist two other times. The Libby, Mont., native holds degrees from Carroll College and Seattle Pacific University.

Kami Malnaa (1st year): Malnaa is in her first year with the Yellowjackets after spending the last two years as the head coach for Yellowstone Valley Christian Home School. The 2002 MSU-Billings graduate starred for the Lady Yellowjackets for four seasons and is currently ranked 17th in school history for career points scored. She also ranks second all-time with 171 made 3-pointers and helped the Jackets to three NCAA Tournament appearances.

Darryl Helmer (1st year): Helmer has been a longtime teacher and coach at Billings Skyview High School. He compiled a 108-96 record from 1990 to 1998 as the Falcon's head girls' basketball coach. Helmer guided the Falcons to a runner up finish at the 1996 State AA Tournament and was a two-time Coach of the Year finalist. At Skyview, Helmer produced several college players including former Yellowjacket standouts Shiloh Schwab and Betsy Morrison.
