This Week's Opponents:

<u>St. Martin's</u> – Saturday's game against the Saints in Lacey could be the biggest of the year for the Yellowjackets. In last week's NCAA West Region poll, St. Martin's was ranked sixth and MSU-Billings was ranked ninth. The top eight teams in the final regional poll qualify for the NCAA Tournament in March.

The Saints gained momentum and important power points with their 59-50 win at MSU-Billings on January 6. That win propelled them into the regional poll for the first time and they have only climbed in the poll since then.

St. Martin's is 7-2 over the last nine games, including a pair of road wins in Alaska last week. A win on the road against the 13-4 Saints would put the Jackets in contention for an NCAA Tournament berth.

Senior center Martina Kartikova still leads the Saints in scoring and rebounding, averaging 18.5 points and 9.1 boards a game. The Jackets held her to just two points in the teams' first meeting.

Beth Layton is averaging 17.7 points a game and has made 48 3pointers. She scored 21 points in Billings last month. Julia Eisentrout, who is scoring 13.5 ppg, netted 17 points against the Jackets in their last meeting. The MSUB defense will have to do a better job of challenging the Saints' perimeter shooters the second time around. Layton, Eisentrout and Lindsay Ford were a combined 16-for-37 from the field and 8-for-19 from 3-point range in January.

Last Week's Results: MSU-Billings 65, Western Oregon 56 North Dakota State 82, MSU-Billings 56

Last Week's Highlights:

North Dakota State stayed unbeaten with an 82-56 win over Montana State-Billings Saturday night. The Bison, who play as a Division I independent, improved to 19-0. The Lady Yellowjackets fell to 14-5.

Leah Klabo, a 6-foot-4 senior center, led the Bison with 26 points on 10-of-15 shooting from the floor and 6-of-6 from the free throw line. Katie Lorenz finished with 15 points and nine assists. Brandee Gibbs and Amanda Krenz added 10 points apiece. The Bison blocked seven shots and out rebounded the Jackets 42-37. Lacey Johnson had three blocks for NDSU.

Tanya Petersen finished with 19 points to lead the Yellowjackets. She was 9-of-20 from the field and also added seven rebounds. Lisa Jellum scored 16 points, hitting 4-of-5 from 3-point range. She has played solid over the last two weeks, scoring in double figures in four of the last five games and averaging 10.4 points.

Kayla Frize scored eight points for the Jackets, connecting on 3-of-3 from the line. MSU-Billings was 9-of-13 from the line in the game. Michelle Lieber added six points and nine rebounds. Senior center Robyn Milne played just 13 minutes in the game and two minutes in the second half. She had four rebounds and three blocked shots.

It was neither easy nor pretty, but the MSU-Billings women survived Western Oregon's upset bid Wednesday night, winning 65-56. The Yellowjackets contained the Wolves' outside shooting in the second half, holding them to 2-of-9 from 3-point range. MSU-Billings still wasn't able to pull away from a game that was tight throughout. There were seven ties in the first half and five in the second with a total of 17 lead changes in the game.

The Yellowjackets took the lead for good on a Tanya Petersen jumper with 10:56 to play, but Western was never down by more than two possessions. MSU-Billings finally found some breathing room in the final five minutes of the game, holding the Wolves scoreless from 5:29 to 1:27. In that span, Robyn Milne was 4-of-6 from the free throw line and Jenny Langford connected on a 3-pointer.

Milne led the Yellowjackets with 17 points, nine rebounds and four blocked shots. The four blocks moved her from No. 23 to No. 22 in NCAA Division II history for career blocked shots with 239. Petersen finished with 14 points on 7-of-13 shooting and six boards. MSU-Billings shot 42 percent from the field in the game. Langford added 12 points, hitting 4-of-9 from the field and 3-of-7 from beyond the arc.

Sophomore Shannon Harvey was 3-of-6 from 3-point range, netting 16 points in the game. She scored 10 first half points to help keep the Jackets close. Michelle Lieber finished with four points and Jessica Bratton added two for the Yellowjackets' only other scoring.

2004-2005 Lady Yellowjacket Coaches

Kevin Woodin (1st year): Woodin takes over the Yellowjackets after a very successful career as the head coach at Billings West High School. He guided the Lady Bears to back-to-back State AA Championships in his final two seasons, including an unbeaten record last year. In ten seasons at West High, Woodin was a combined 138-81 for a .610 winning percentage. He was a two-time Montana Coach of the Year and a finalist two other times. The Libby, Mont., native holds degrees from Carroll College and Seattle Pacific University.

Kami Malnaa (1st year): Malnaa is in her first year with the Yellowjackets after spending the last two years as the head coach for Yellowstone Valley Christian Home School. The 2002 MSU-Billings graduate starred for the Lady Yellowjackets for four seasons and is currently ranked 17th in school history for career points scored. She also ranks second all-time with 171 made 3-pointers and helped the Jackets to three NCAA Tournament appearances.

Darryl Helmer (1st year): Helmer has been a longtime teacher and coach at Billings Skyview High School. He compiled a 108-96 record from 1990 to 1998 as the Falcon's head girls' basketball coach. Helmer guided the Falcons to a runner up finish at the 1996 State AA Tournament and was a two-time Coach of the Year finalist. At Skyview, Helmer produced several college players including former Yellowjacket standouts Shiloh Schwab and Betsy Morrison.
