<u>Western Oregon University</u> – The Wolves are the next hurdle between MSUB and the NCAA Tournament. Four straight wins will most likely assure the Jackets of a tourney appearance, and the stretch run starts in Monmouth, OR, on Tuesday.

WOU almost upset the Yellowjackets in Billings on Jan. 26 before MSUB pulled out a 65-56 win. Since then, the Wolves have struggled, winning just one of seven games. WOU is 5-18 overall and averaging 53.4 points per game. The Wolves rely primarily on two players. Shannon Talbott averages 14.9 points and 9.1 rebounds a game, and Kagney Kohne averages 13.5 points and 5.0 rebounds.

Just one day after a 21 point win, Montana State-Billings needed overtime Saturday night to dispatch Grand Canyon University. The Lady Yellowjackets outscored the Antelopes 10-7 in the extra period, winning 80-77 to improve to 17-6.

Senior Robyn Milne capped off her final home game by hitting the game winning basket with 18 seconds left in overtime. The Yellowjackets swung the ball from left to right around the perimeter, setting up guard Jenny Langford's entry pass into Milne who had sealed her defender in the paint. Milne made the layup and was fouled; her free throw gave the Jackets their final margin of victory.

Back-to-back baskets from reserve forward Jessica Bratton ended an 11-3 Yellowjacket run that gave MSUB an 18-17. Bratton's second basket with 13:32 to play in the first half erased Grand Canyon's final lead of the game.

Behind 12 points from Milne, the Yellowjackets were able to build a tenuous 44-38 halftime lead. Tanya Petersen scored eight first half points, and Langford added nine.

The Yellowjackets had their opportunities to pull away midway through the second half. Michelle Lieber's put back at 12:59 gave MSUB a 55-47 lead. The Jackets held eight point leads on four different occasions over the next three minutes.

Both teams had their chances to win in the final seconds of regulation. Milne converted two free throws to give the Yellowjackets a two point lead with 43 seconds to play, but the defense wasn't able to hold. Grand Canyon tied the game with 25 seconds remaining.

The Jackets struck first in overtime and never trailed. Milne scored on a layup on a nice feed from Petersen to give MSUB a 72-70 lead. On the next two Yellowjacket possessions, Lieber and Milne converted four straight free throws, giving the Jackets a 76-72 advantage with 3:27 to play.

Grand Canyon responded with a Sherlyn Hatch jumper to cut the lead to two. After Langford hit one of two free throws, GCU's Jennifer Cobb struck again with her sixth 3-pointer to tie the game at 77-77 with 39 seconds on the clock. That set up Milne's game winner end on the next possession. Grand Canyon had a chance to tie the game with time running out, but Lieber blocked Cobb's 3-point attempt from the baseline and Lisa Jellum corralled the rebound.

Milne finished the night with 26 points, nine rebounds and three blocked shots. Her three blocks moved her to No. 17 on the NCAA Division II all-time list. She was 12-of-17 from the free throw line and made her last seven attempts. Petersen netted 17 points, and Langford finished with 15. Lieber and Shannon Harvey each added six points off the bench

The Yellowjackets put the clamps on Grand Canyon Friday night and coasted to a 67-46 win. Milne recorded her 27^{th} career double-double with 10 points and 11 rebounds, and topped off the night by swatting five shots on the defensive end.

The Jackets' defense led to 38 first half points and a 12 point halftime lead. Fourteen was as close as Grand Canyon could get in the second half as the Yellowjacket defense held the 'Lopes to7-of-27 shooting. After a 3-pointer with 15:35 to play cut the Jackets' lead to 43-29, MSU-Billings used a 16-2 run to break the game open.

MSUB's big three of Milne, Lieber and Petersen were a combined 17-of-31 from the field for 38 points. They also combined for 24 rebounds while none of the three played more than 26 minutes. The Yellowjackets held a 56-34 rebounding edge with 16 offensive rebounds leading to 16 second chance points.

Petersen led the Yellowjackets with 16 points on 7-of-12 shooting from the field. She was also 2-of-2 from beyond the arc. Lieber finished with 12 points and nine rebounds, and Harvey came off the bench to score 11 points. Eleven different Yellowjackets found the scoring column with the bench contributing 23 points—16 in the second half.

Notes: Robyn Milne needs just five points to reach 1,000 for her career. She is also just four rebounds short of 900. She is likely to accomplish both on Tuesday at Western Oregon. Brandy Hamblin is the only player in school history with 1,000 points and 900 rebounds. Milne is also chasing the school blocked shot record. She has 256 career blocks, 16 behind Jessie Henigman's 272. Henigman ranks 14th in NCAA Division II history, while Milne moved up to 17th with eight blocks last weekend. Jenny Langford moved to 4th in school history for career 3-pointers last weekend.

2004-2005 Lady Yellowjacket Coaches

Kevin Woodin (1st year): Woodin takes over the Yellowjackets after a very successful career as the head coach at Billings West High School. He guided the Lady Bears to back-to-back State AA Championships in his final two seasons, including an unbeaten record last year. In ten seasons at West High, Woodin was a combined 138-81 for a .610 winning percentage. He was a two-time Montana Coach of the Year and a finalist two other times. The Libby, Mont., native holds degrees from Carroll College and Seattle Pacific University.

Kami Malnaa (1st year): Malnaa is in her first year with the Yellowjackets after spending the last two years as the head coach for Yellowstone Valley Christian Home School. The 2002 MSU-Billings graduate starred for the Lady Yellowjackets for four seasons and is currently ranked 17th in school history for career points scored. She also ranks second all-time with 171 made 3-pointers and helped the Jackets to three NCAA Tournament appearances.

Darryl Helmer (1st year): Helmer has been a longtime teacher and coach at Billings Skyview High School. He compiled a 108-96 record from 1990 to 1998 as the Falcon's head girls' basketball coach. Helmer guided the Falcons to a runner up finish at the 1996 State AA Tournament and was a two-time Coach of the Year finalist. At Skyview, Helmer produced several college players including former Yellowjacket standouts Shiloh Schwab and Betsy Morrison.
