This Week's Opponent:

Northwest Nazarene University – The Crusaders started the season by winning four of their first five games, but they have dropped four straight dating back to December 4. Three of those four games were on the road, and NNU will be looking to bounce back on their home court against the Yellowjackets Monday evening.

The only common opponent between the two teams this season has been Humboldt State. The Yellowiackets swept the Lumberjacks— 58-44 and 77-45—in mid December. The Crusaders defeated Humboldt, 74-60, on December 2.

Three Crusaders are scoring in double figures. Danielle Pridgen leads the team at 14.7 ppg. The 6-foot sophomore is also the team's leading rebounder at 8.0 rpg. Guard Jessica Metz is averaging 11.9 points a game, followed by Whitney VanBrocklin's 10.3 ppg.

St. Martin's College – The Saints are off to a blistering start at 7-2. Their only losses have been to Boise State and Chico State. They have an impressive +18.9 scoring margin and are averaging 77 points a game.

Two players are averaging 20 points a game for St. Martin's—Beth Layton and Martina Kartikova. The duo is accounting for nearly half of the Saints' offensive production. Layton, a guard, has 31 3pointers in nine games. Kartikova, a 6-foot forward, averages almost a double-double with 9.6 rebounds a game.

While the Yellowjackets have a +16.7 scoring margin behind strong defense and a +9.3 rebounding margin, the Saints have relied on defense and turnovers. Their turnover margin is +9.2 and they are forcing opponents into 25.0 turnovers per game.

MSU-Billings 86, MSU-Billings Alumni 78

Last Week's Highlights:

The Montana State-Billings women's basketball team pulled away for an 86-78 exhibition victory over an MSU-Billings alumni team on Friday. The Yellowjackets (9-2) return to regular season action on January 3 when they play a West Region game at Northwest Nazarene. MSU-Billings next plays at home on January 6 in another West Region contest against St. Martin's.

Ten of the twelve players who saw action for MSU-Billings scored. Michelle Lieber led the Yellowjackets with 17 points. Kayla Frize and Tanya Petersen each netted 13 points. Petersen made four 3-pointers, and Frize had two 3-pointers. Jenny Langford knocked down three 3-pointers and finished with 11 points. The Yellowjackets made 11 3-pointers as a team.

The alumni were led by Deena (Bartu) Garbett's game-high 31 points. The 2000 MSUB grad had three 3-pointers and was 7-of-8 from the free throw line. Kami Malnaa, a 2002 grad, netted 23 points with four 3-pointers. Malnaa is currently an assistant coach with the Yellowjackets.

2004-2005 Lady Yellowjacket Coaches

Kevin Woodin (1st year): Woodin takes over the Yellowjackets after a very successful career as the head coach at Billings West High School. He guided the Lady Bears to back-to-back State AA Championships in his final two seasons, including an unbeaten record last year. In ten seasons at West High, Woodin was a combined 138-81 for a .610 winning percentage. He was a two-time Montana Coach of the Year and a finalist two other times. The Libby, Mont., native holds degrees from Carroll College and Seattle Pacific University.

Kami Malnaa (1st year): Malnaa is in her first year with the Yellowjackets after spending the last two years as the head coach for Yellowstone Valley Christian Home School. The 2002 MSU-Billings graduate starred for the Lady Yellowjackets for four seasons and is currently ranked 17th in school history for career points scored. She also ranks second all-time with 171 made 3-pointers and helped the Jackets to three NCAA Tournament appearances.

Darryl Helmer (1st year): Helmer has been a longtime teacher and coach at Billings Skyview High School. He compiled a 108-96 record from 1990 to 1998 as the Falcon's head girls' basketball coach. Helmer guided the Falcons to a runner up finish at the 1996 State AA Tournament and was a two-time Coach of the Year finalist. At Skyview, Helmer produced several college players including former Yellowjacket standouts Shiloh Schwab and Betsy Morrison.
