This Week's Opponents:

University of the Incarnate Word – The Cardinals are in the middle of the Heartland Conference pack, entering the week with a 4-5 record in the conference and 7-17 overall. Despite the losing record, a strong finish could still put the Cards in the Heartland Conference playoffs.

The Cardinals are led by one of the most explosive guards in the conference, Kim Robinson. The sophomore ranks fourth in the conference for scoring at 14.2 ppg. She has led UIW in scoring in 11 of 24 games, including a season-high 27 points against MSU-Billings on January 11. Erika Pink has led the team in scoring seven times and averages 13.8 ppg.

St. Mary's University – The Rattlers enter the week within striking distance of first place in the conference. At 13-10 overall and 6-3 in the league, two conference wins this week could vault them to the top of the league standings. STMU will play at winless Lincoln on Tuesday before traveling to Billings for two games against the Yellowjackets. Friday's game will count in the conference standings and Saturday's will be a non-conference game.

After missing five games because of injury—including the Yellowjackets' win in San Antonio in January—Flavia Azinheira is back in uniform for the Rattlers. She averages 16.4 points per game, which would rank first in the league if she had played enough games to qualify for league statistical rankings. The 6-foot sophomore from Mozambique also averages 6.9 rebounds. Charlena Rodez adds 12.2 points and 4.1 rebounds a game. Dawn Killian leads the team with 41 three-pointers on the season.

Last Week's Highlights:

Sometimes teams just have bad weeks, and that's what happened to the Lady Yellowjackets last week. They had their school-record 14 game winning streak snapped on Friday, losing to St. Edward's in overtime. They then had one of their worst shooting nights of the year on Saturday, falling to the Hilltoppers by 10.

On Friday the Jackets battled back from a six-point second half deficit to force overtime. MSU-Billings led 72-71 in overtime with time running out, but a foul with 3.1 seconds on the clock sent the Hilltoppers' Tammy Bartosh to the line. She knocked down both free throws and Alira Carpenter's half court heave fell just short at the buzzer. Carpenter finished with 16 points. Michelle Lieber posted a double-double of 22 points and 11 rebounds. Lisa Jellum and Jenny Langford also scored in double figures with 12 and 11 respectively.

Saturday's game was an offensive struggle from the start. The Yellowjackets shot just 34.8 percent from the field and 35 percent from behind the arc. Shannon Harvey had a big second half with five 3-pointers and 17 points. Lieber finished with another double-double, scoring 15 points and grabbing 11 boards. Jellum added 10 points and four assists.

Kevin Woodin (2nd year): Woodin led the Yellowjackets to a 21-7 record and an NCAA Tournament berth in his first season. He was named the NCAA Division II Independent Coach of the Year. Woodin took over at MSU-Billings after a very successful career as the head coach at Billings West High School. He guided the Lady Bears to back-to-back State AA Championships in his final two seasons, including an unbeaten record in 2003-2004. In ten seasons at West High, Woodin was a combined 138-81 for a .610 winning percentage. He was a two-time Montana Coach of the Year. The Libby, Mont., native holds degrees from Carroll College and Seattle Pacific University.

Kami Malnaa (2nd year): Malnaa is in her second year with the Yellowjackets after spending two years as the head coach for Yellowstone Valley Christian Home School. The 2002 MSU-Billings graduate starred for the Lady Yellowjackets for four seasons and is currently ranked 19th in school history for career points scored. She also ranks second all-time with 171 made 3-pointers and helped the Jackets to three NCAA Tournament appearances.

Darryl Helmer (2nd year): Helmer has been a longtime teacher and coach at Billings Skyview High School. He compiled a 108-96 record from 1990 to 1998 as the Falcon's head girls' basketball coach. Helmer guided the Falcons to a runner up finish at the 1996 State AA Tournament and was a two-time Coach of the Year finalist. At Skyview, Helmer produced several college players including former Yellowjacket standouts Shiloh Schwab and Betsy Morrison.
