This Week's Opponents:

Lady Yellowjacket Alumni – Seven former college players are scheduled to lace up against the Yellowjackets on Friday in the team's annual Alumni Game with one or two more potentially being added to the roster at the end of the week. The seven include six former Lady Yellowjackets and one player who played at University of Mary.

The Alumni will have a size advantage when they match up against the 2005-2006 Yellowjackets. They will suit up four players who are 6-foot or taller. From the 1999 NCAA Elite Eight team will be Krista (Fjelstad) Montague and Alicia (Cahill) Hutzenbiler. Montague is still second in school history for career free throw percentage, and Hutzenbiler ranks twelfth in school history for points scored and third for rebounds.

The top two shot blockers in school history will also be in uniform. Robyn Milne, a 2005 graduate, ranks thirteenth in NCAA Division II history with 278 career blocked shots. Jessie Henigman, a 2003 graduate, is sixteenth in NCAA II history with 272 career blocked shots. Milne is also first in Lady Jacket history with 957 rebounds and sixteenth in school history with 1,066 points. Henigman is eleventh in school history for rebounds and 26th for points.

At guard the Yellowjacket Alumni will suit up 2002 graduate and current assistant coach Kami Malnaa along with 2003 graduate and current graduate assistant coach Jessica (Bachman) Wandler. Malnaa still ranks nineteenth in school history for scoring and second for 3-point shooting. Wandler is 23rd in Lady Jacket history for scoring and sixth for 3-point shooting. Erin (Giese) Breen, a 1999 graduate of University of Mary, will also play for the Alumni.

Last Week's Highlights:

If any week could be described as a rollercoaster week, it was last week for the Lady Yellowjackets. On Monday they lost their Heartland Conference opener at Oklahoma Panhandle, 67-56. It was the fourth-straight loss for the Jackets, and they averaged just 57 points per game during that stretch.

Following Monday's loss, the Yellowjackets returned to Billings for just two nights before hitting the road again for two tough games in Denver against teams that received votes in the WBCA national poll.

The Yellowjackets put together one of their best offensive performances of the season on Friday in an 87-62 blowout of Metro State. The Jackets shot a blistering 62 percent from the field and were 8-of-19 from 3-point range. Petersen narrowly missed her first triple-double with 17 points, 12 rebounds and a career-high nine assists. Lieber missed just one shot all night, going 11-of-12 from the field for a career-high 24 points. Jenny Langford, who missed the previous three games, added 15 points and six assists.

The momentum from Friday's win carried over to Sunday when the Yellowjackets faced 25th-ranked Regis University. MSUB shot 48 percent from the field and 90 percent from the free throw line in the 82-74 upset of the nationally-ranked Rangers.

Shannon Harvey came off the bench to score a game-high 18 points, knocking down four 3-pointers. Langford had another solid game with 17 points, hitting 3-of-5 from behind the arc as the Jackets made 8-of-17 from long range. She was also assigned defensive duties on the Rangers' Diana Lopez, who entered the game averaging 24 points a game. Lopez finished with 16 points and was just 1-of-5 from 3-point range.

Lieber recorded her second double-double of the week with 11 points and 11 rebounds. For the week she was 24-of-29 from the field for a field goal percentage of 82.8 percent. For the season Lieber is shooting at a 64 percent clip, tops in the Heartland Conference.

Kevin Woodin (2nd year): Woodin led the Yellowjackets to a 21-7 record and an NCAA Tournament berth in his first season. He was named the NCAA Division II Independent Coach of the Year. Woodin took over at MSU-Billings after a very successful career as the head coach at Billings West High School. He guided the Lady Bears to back-to-back State AA Championships in his final two seasons, including an unbeaten record in 2003-2004. In ten seasons at West High, Woodin was a combined 138-81 for a .610 winning percentage. He was a two-time Montana Coach of the Year. The Libby, Mont., native holds degrees from Carroll College and Seattle Pacific University.

Kami Malnaa (2nd year): Malnaa is in her second year with the Yellowjackets after spending two years as the head coach for Yellowstone Valley Christian Home School. The 2002 MSU-Billings graduate starred for the Lady Yellowjackets for four seasons and is currently ranked 19th in school history for career points scored. She also ranks second all-time with 171 made 3-pointers and helped the Jackets to three NCAA Tournament appearances.

Darryl Helmer (2nd year): Helmer has been a longtime teacher and coach at Billings Skyview High School. He compiled a 108-96 record from 1990 to 1998 as the Falcon's head girls' basketball coach. Helmer guided the Falcons to a runner up finish at the 1996 State AA Tournament and was a two-time Coach of the Year finalist. At Skyview, Helmer produced several college players including former Yellowjacket standouts Shiloh Schwab and Betsy Morrison.
