## This Week's Opponents:

Abilene Christian University - The Wildcats are picked to win the Lone Star Conference South division ahead of Angelo State and West Texas A\&M. WTAMU defeated MSU-Billings in Texas in November. The Wildcats were 20-10 last year and made their first trip to the NCAA Tournament since 1999. They lost in the first round to Drury.

The Wildcats entered last week with a 4-3 record, but consecutive losses have them at 4-5 going into Tuesday's game against the Yellowjackets at Alterowitz Gym. The Wildcats dropped their conference-opener at home on Friday night, losing 83-68 to Angelo State. After flying to Billings on Saturday, the Wildcats let one get away to St. Martin's, falling 87-74. Abilene opened the game with a 14-1 run and led by as many as 16 , but the Saints' free throw shooting and second chance points did in the Wildcats.

ACU is led by senior center Jamie Boles-Lord, the preseason MVP in the Lone Star Conference. The 6 -foot- 1 center is averaging 11.9 points and 7.1 rebounds a game. She scored 14 points on 6 -of- 11 shooting from the field on Sunday before fouling out.

Alex Guiton, a 5-5 sophomore guard, found the Alterowitz rims to her liking on Sunday, scoring a team-high 20 points. She entered the contest averaging 10.7 ppg . Guiton was 5-of-10 from the field and 9-of11 from the free throw line. She also handed out five assists.

Ashley King, a 5-7 senior guard, entered Sunday's game averaging over 12 ppg, but was held to just three points by St. Martin's. She did grab a team-high 10 rebounds. Ashlee Barr came off the bench to score 15 points, hitting three of the team's six 3-pointers.

Tuesday's game will be the first ever between the Jackets and Wildcats who are now members of the same region. ACU should provide a good measuring stick for MSUB in terms of how it stacks up in the South Central Region. The Wildcats are also the Yellowjackets' fourthstraight opponent that was an NCAA Tournament qualifier last year.

## Last Week's Highlights Continued:

In all, seven different Yellowjackets connected from 3-point range. Along with Langford's five triples, Alira Carpenter made a careerhigh four 3-pointers, and Shannon Harvey added three. Kayla McPherson made two off the bench, and Michelle Lieber, Jennifer Skrifvars, and Jetton Meadors each made one.

It was less than a year ago that the Saints came to Billings and stole a $59-50$ win at Alterowitz. St. Martin's then went on to advance to the West Region semifinals. Friday's game was a different story as the Saints had no answer for the Jackets' inside-outside combination. The Jackets' 3 -point shooters benefited from a fast start in the paint as the team's first 10 points of the game were scored on layups.

Three of those opening layups came from Lieber, who was 4-of-4 from the field in the game-including her first-ever collegiate 3pointer. For the season Lieber is shooting a conference-best 66 percent from the field. In her last four games she has missed a total of five shots in 33 attempts ( 85 percent).

Carpenter officially introduced herself to Yellowjacket fans with a game-high 21 points on Friday in her first collegiate start at home. She has started the last five games. Carpenter was 8 -of- 13 from the field and 4 -of-6 from 3-point range. The true freshman from Lewistown is averaging 9.9 ppg and is third on the team with a dozen 3 -pointers.

Not showing up in the conference stats leaders (see below) is senior guard Jenny Langford, who has been solid the last three games. To be eligible for the conference statistical rankings, a player must appear in 75 percent of her team's games. Langford has missed three of the Jackets' eight games, so she's appeared in just 63 percent. She won't become eligible for the statistical rankings until the team's twelfth game, which will come in early January. If she were eligible now, she would rank seventh in the Heartland for scoring (13.6), sixth for field goal percentage (46.9), second for assists (3.6), first for 3-point percentage (53.3), and first for 3-pointers per game (3.2). In her last three games Langford is 11 -of- 20 from behind the arc. At the same time she's been burning up the nets, she has also been assigned to defend the opponent's top scorer, holding those three players to an average of 11.7 ppg . Two of those three players entered their games against the Yellowjackets averaging over 20 ppg .

## 2005-2006 Lady Yellowjacket Coaches



Kevin Woodin (2 ${ }^{\text {nd }}$ year): Woodin led the Yellowjackets to a 21-7 record and an NCAA Tournament berth in his first season. He was named the NCAA Division II Independent Coach of the Year. Woodin took over at MSU-Billings after a very successful career as the head coach at Billings West High School. He guided the Lady Bears to back-to-back State AA Championships in his final two seasons, including an unbeaten record in 2003-2004. In ten seasons at West High, Woodin was a combined 138-81 for a . 610 winning percentage. He was a two-time Montana Coach of the Year. The Libby, Mont., native holds degrees from Carroll College and Seattle Pacific University.

Kami Malnaa ( ${ }^{\text {nd }}$ year): Malnaa is in her second year with the Yellowjackets after spending two years as the head coach for Yellowstone Valley Christian Home School. The 2002 MSU-Billings graduate starred for the Lady Yellowjackets for four seasons and is currently ranked $19^{\text {th }}$ in school history for career points scored. She also ranks second all-time with 171 made 3-pointers and helped the Jackets to three NCAA Tournament appearances.

Darryl Helmer (2 ${ }^{\text {nd }}$ year): Helmer has been a longtime teacher and coach at Billings Skyview High School. He compiled a 108-96 record from 1990 to 1998 as the Falcon's head girls' basketball coach. Helmer guided the Falcons to a runner up finish at the 1996 State AA Tournament and was a two-time Coach of the Year finalist. At Skyview, Helmer produced several college players including former Yellowjacket standouts Shiloh Schwab and Betsy Morrison.
