This Week's Opponent:

Lincoln University – The Blue Tigers are winless on the season at 0-16 overall and 0-6 in the Heartland Conference. They will bus from Jefferson City, MO, for the weekend series in Billings.

Both the Blue Tigers and Yellowjackets have played just one game since they last met on January 21 in Jefferson City. In a game that was close for the first 10 minutes, the Yellowjackets pulled away for a 22-point win, 78-56. Nine different Yellowjackets scored at least five points in that game.

The Blue Tigers will come to Billings averaging just 50.1 points per game while giving up 72.4. Their top scorer, guard Sylvia Guldalian, missed several games because of injury early in the season, but she did return to action to score a game-high 17 points when the Jackets and Tigers met in Jefferson City.

Guldalian averages 11.2 points per game, but has played in just nine games this season. She has averaged 13.5 in her last two games since returning. Tiffanie Wolfe adds 11.1 points per game as well as a team-best 6.9 rebounds a game. She had 11 points and nine boards when the Jackets and Tigers played last.

Last Week's Highlights:

Saturday's game against St. Edward's was the biggest of the season so far for the Lady Yellowjackets. With just a half game separating the teams in the conference standings, the winner was set to take over first place at the halfway point of the conference season.

The one-two inside punch of Michelle Lieber and Tanya Petersen combined to score 42 points Saturday to lead the Jackets to a 78-64 win. The win was the twelfth-straight for the Lady Jackets, setting a new school record. MSU-Billings improved to 13-4 overall and 6-1 in the Heartland Conference. The win gave the Lady Jackets a game and a half lead over St. Edward's in the conference standings.

The Yellowjackets led for all but about three and a half minutes of the game. The Hilltoppers took an early 3-0 lead on a 3-point play in the paint by Tammy Bartosh. The Yellowjackets tied the game 2:23 into the game on a pair of Lieber free throws and never trailed again.

Last Week's Highlights Continued:

MSU-Billings built its lead to double digits by the 11 minute mark of the first half and didn't allow the Hilltoppers inside of 10 the rest of the way. A Jenny Langford 3-pointer from the corner as time expired in the first half gave the Lady Jackets a 21-point advantage, 43-22.

The Yellowjackets' lead ranged between 15 and 20 for most of the first ten minutes of the second half before the Hilltoppers climbed back into the game. Sara Baca scored nine of the Hilltoppers' 11 points in a span of about four and a half minutes midway through the second half to cut the Jackets' lead to 10. A jumper by Baca in the paint with 9:49 to play pulled St. Ed's to within 60-50.

MSU-Billings answered back and eventually built the lead back to 15. The Yellowjackets made 8-of-10 free throws in the final 2:42 to pull away. The Jackets shot 67.5 percent from the free throw line in the game.

Lieber finished with a career-high 25 points. She hit 7-of-8 shots from the field and 11-of-18 from the free throw line. Petersen posted a double-double on the night with 17 points and 10 rebounds. The Yellowjackets out-rebounded the Hilltoppers 33-30.

Langford scored eight points and grabbed six rebounds. She had two of the Jackets' seven 3-pointers, tying Kami Malnaa for second all-time in school history with 171 career 3-pointers. Petersen also made two from behind the arc. Freshman Alira Carpenter added 10 points and two assists for the Jackets. Fellow freshman Jen Smith added four off the bench. Shannon Harvey scored nine points, hitting 6-of-6 from the free throw line.

Kevin Woodin (2nd year): Woodin led the Yellowjackets to a 21-7 record and an NCAA Tournament berth in his first season. He was named the NCAA Division II Independent Coach of the Year. Woodin took over at MSU-Billings after a very successful career as the head coach at Billings West High School. He guided the Lady Bears to back-to-back State AA Championships in his final two seasons, including an unbeaten record in 2003-2004. In ten seasons at West High, Woodin was a combined 138-81 for a .610 winning percentage. He was a two-time Montana Coach of the Year. The Libby, Mont., native holds degrees from Carroll College and Seattle Pacific University.

Kami Malnaa (2nd year): Malnaa is in her second year with the Yellowjackets after spending two years as the head coach for Yellowstone Valley Christian Home School. The 2002 MSU-Billings graduate starred for the Lady Yellowjackets for four seasons and is currently ranked 19th in school history for career points scored. She also ranks second all-time with 171 made 3-pointers and helped the Jackets to three NCAA Tournament appearances.

Darryl Helmer (2nd year): Helmer has been a longtime teacher and coach at Billings Skyview High School. He compiled a 108-96 record from 1990 to 1998 as the Falcon's head girls' basketball coach. Helmer guided the Falcons to a runner up finish at the 1996 State AA Tournament and was a two-time Coach of the Year finalist. At Skyview, Helmer produced several college players including former Yellowjacket standouts Shiloh Schwab and Betsy Morrison.
