North Dakota

Opponent Series Records:

MSU-Billings Wins: 0 North Dakota Wins: 4

The Fighting Sioux are coming off a North Central Conference championship returning four starters to the 2006-07 roster. They were 34-1 overall and 12-0 in the conference last year. The team lost both captains to graduation and will now look to Kelsey Maffin and Carissa Jahner for leadership. Maffin recorded 6.2 ppg last season while Jahner led the NCC with 3.10 assist/turnover ratio. She was named the 05-06 Co-Defensive Player of the Year for the second straight year by the NCC. Jahner averaged 9.1 ppg, 3.7 apg, and 1.8 spg last season. Ashley Langen is also a dangerous presence for the Fighting Sioux averaging 16 ppg and 8.4 rpg. UND is off to a 3-0 start in 06-07 after winning their division at the Disney Tip Off Classic.

Metro State

The Roadrunners were picked to finish second in the RMAC in a recent pre-season poll. Metro finished the 2005-06 season 18-9 overall. One of their losses came at the hands of MSUB when the Jackets shocked the Roadrunners in Denver last year, winning 87-62. Paige Powers, a returning guard, was selected All-RMAC in the preseason after averaging 16 ppg last year. Powers also led the Roadrunners with a .408 three-point percentage. She knocked down 62 threes last season. Leading the Roadrunners' charge alongside Powers is senior Rianna Harris. Harris swatted 35 shots, grabbed 8.4 rpg, and averaged 13.4 ppg last season.

Western Oregon

MSU-Billings Wins: 7 Western Oregon Wins: 2

The Wolves are a member of the Great Northwest Athletic Conference in which the Jackets will be joining July 1, 2007. The Wolves went a disappointing 0-27 for the 2005-06 season but under new head coach Greg Bruce look for things to change. Bruce brings a wealth of experience to the Western Oregon program. Leada Berkey returns as the leading scorer after averaging 11.9 ppg to go with 7.8 rpg. Berkey ranked 13th in the GNAC in scoring and 5th for rebounding. Teammate Allison Crumb averaged 8.7 ppg and had a team-leading 34 steals.

The Week in Review

The Yellowjackets had a busy preseason schedule with three tough exhibition games. Two of the three were against NCAA Division I teams, and the third was against cross-town rival Rocky Mountain.

The Jackets opened the exhibition season on November 2 at Montana State in Bozeman. The young Yellowjackets made a strong showing considering they had been practicing less than three weeks. MSUB led by double digits in the first half and held the lead until the final four minutes of the game. Senior forward Michelle Lieber fouled out with about eight minutes to play, and the Bobcats were able to slowly claw their way into the lead. The Cats hit their free throws down the stretch and held on for a 75-69 win. Alira Carpenter scored a game-high 24 points. Lieber and Kayla McPherson each finished with 14.

The Jackets traveled down Poly Drive to face Rocky Mountain on November 7. MSUB scored the first 12 points of the game and held the Bears scoreless for the first seven and a half minutes of the game. The Yellowjackets would build their lead to 20 in the second half before Rocky trimmed the final margin to 60-48. Carpenter again led all players with 17 points. Lieber netted 15 and grabbed nine rebounds. McPherson knocked down three of the Jackets' five 3-pointers and scored 11 points. Freshman Shantell Marquis was a game-changer on the defensive end with six steals.

MSUB wrapped up the exhibition season with an 89-45 loss at University of Montana. The Jackets' youth was evident against the deep and talented Grizzlies. The Jackets didn't reach double figures until less than eight minutes remaining in the first half, and by that point they were already down 20. MSUB shot just 23 percent from the field in the game, including a 4-for-19 showing from 3-point range. Marquis was the only MSUB player in double figures with 14 points. She hit 7-of-10 free throws. Lieber added eight points and seven rebounds.

Tip Ins

Although there have been a few early season tournaments (North Dakota is already 3-0 after the Disney Tip Off Classic), the NCAA basketball season hits full swing across the country this weekend. Heartland Conference teams will be in action in 14 games between November 15 and 18, playing a very wide range of teams....The Heartland Conference released its pre-season polls this week. Even though they graduated five players off last year's co-championship team, the Yellowjackets were picked to finish first in the conference by a fairly substantial margin. Give some credit for that to the Jackets' history. They have gone to nine NCAA Tournaments since 1994. Another big factor in the balloting was likely the fact that the Jackets return reigning Heartland player of the year Michelle Lieber and last year's freshman of the year Alira Carpenter. Lieber was named to the preseason all-conference team....Following a busy opening weekend hosting the Chinook Wireless/Holiday Inn Yellowjacket Classic, MSUB will have nine days off before its next game on November 28. The Jackets should enjoy the rest, because starting with a home game against Rocky on the 28th, they will play five games in 12 days, including road trips to Missouri and Washington.
