Rocky Mountain

The Bears will bring a 3-4 record to Alterowitz Gym for Tuesday's non-conference game with the Yellowjackets. Rocky started the season 3-1 but has lost three straight. During the three-game skid the Bears have fallen to Black Hills State twice and South Dakota Tech once. The Bears lost 60-48 to the Yellowjackets on November 7 at Rocky's Fortin Center. The game was an exhibition for the Yellowjackets, but it counted in the Bears' season record. Since the game was an exhibition, it does not count in the overall series record between the two schools. MSUB currently has a nine-game winning streak against the Bears dating back to 1998. The last time Rocky defeated MSUB was January 7, 1998. Rocky's last win at MSUB was February 20, 1980. No season statistics are available for Rocky Mountain.

Northwest Missouri State

The Bearcats enter the week with a 4-1 record. They will host William Penn on Tuesday before taking on the Yellowjackets on Thursday. Northwest Missouri started the season with four-straight wins with an average margin of victory of 20.75 points. Their lone loss came at 16th-ranked Western Washington last weekend, falling 81-74 in overtime. The Bearcats have a balanced inside-outside scoring attack with four players averaging double figures. Jessica Burton averages 12.8 points and 5.0 rebounds a game. Post player Mandi Schumacher adds 12.2 points and a team-best 7.4 rebounds a game. Guards Meghan Brue and Kelli Nelson average 11.4 and 10.4 ppg respectively. NMSU has held opponents to a 3-point percentage of 21.8 percent. The Yellowjackets and Bearcats have never met.

<u>Missouri Western State</u>

The Griffons are 4-0 entering the week. They will host Harris-Stowe on Wednesday before entertaining the Yellowjackets on Saturday. The Griffons will be working on a 24-game non-conference home winning streak. The same five players have started all four games so far, and the Griffons' top six all average at least seven points per game. Senior center Inga Buzoka has posted four double-doubles and averages 20.3 points, 13.5 rebounds, and 3.0 blocked shots. Renata deAlmeida adds 10.8 ppg off the bench. Jill Johnson averages 9.0 points and 7.3 rebounds. Guard Tiffany Davis averages 8.5 points and leads the team with 6.25 assists per game. Opponents are only shooting 36 percent from the field against the Griffons, including 28 percent from behind the arc. The Yellowjackets and Griffons have never met.

The Week in Review

The Yellowjackets hosted Western Oregon, North Dakota, and Metro State on the 17th and 18th in the second annual Chinook Wireless/Holiday Inn Grand Montana Yellowjacket Classic. After a slow start on Friday, the Jackets overpowered Western Oregon 77-62. MSUB had as many offensive rebounds in the game, 33, as the Wolves had total rebounds. Four Yellowjackets scored in double figures, including a pair of double-doubles from the post players. Michelle Lieber scored a game-high 20 to go with 16 rebounds. Dani Henderson finished with 15 points and 11 rebounds in her first collegiate game. Guards Alira Carpenter and Shantell Marquis added 12 and 10 points respectively and combined for five of the team's nine 3-pointers.

On Saturday the Jackets faced North Dakota, the nation's second-ranked team. There were five lead changes and four ties in the first nine and a half minutes of a defensive first half. The Sioux pulled away from a 30-25 halftime lead to lead by double digits much of the second half. UND held off a late MSUB rally to win 71-62. Carpenter scored 15 points and grabbed a career-high seven rebounds. Lieber finished with 12 points and five boards. Jetton Meadors and Jen Smith each posted career highs with eight points. Lieber and Carpenter were named to the all-tournament team.

Tip Ins

After wrapping up the Chinook Wireless/Holiday Inn Grand Montana Yellowjacket Classic on the 18th, the Yellowjackets have had a nine-day break. The young Yellowjacket team will be introduced to the rigors of college basketball with five games in three states in the next 12 days. After Tuesday's home game against Rocky, the Jackets play two games in Missouri over the weekend. They return home for one game against University of Mary next Wednesday before flying to Seattle to take on St. Martin's next Saturday....The youth movement has taken hold for the Lady Jackets. In their last game against North Dakota, Coach Kevin Woodin started two freshmen and two sophomores. Freshmen Dani Henderson and Shantell Marquis have been valuable additions so far. Both scored in double figures in their first collegiate games last week....The Jackets' non-conference schedule may prove to be tougher than their conference slate. Northwest Missouri State and Missouri Western State are a combined 8-1 coming into this week. On the horizon are Mary, St. Martin's, Abilene Christian, and Missouri Southern....Heartland Conference teams have not done particularly well in the early non-conference season. Including the Jackets at 1-1, the league is a combined 6-18. St. Mary's and St. Edward's, expected to compete for the conference title, are a combined 1-8....Michelle Lieber was named the Heartland Conference player of the week for the first week of the 2006-2007 season. She averaged 16 points and 10.5 rebounds a game last week and became the 27th player in school history to eclipse 700 career points.
