# Abilene Christian University

The Wildcats started the season 7-0 and will enter this week with an 8-2 mark. Both of their losses came on the road two weeks ago. ACU is 6-0 at home and 2-2 away from Abilene. The Wildcats don't have any common opponents with the Yellowjackets yet, but they have gone 4-0 against Heartland Conference teams (5-0 including provisional member Texas-Permian Basin). They opened the season with double-digit wins against Incarnate Word and St. Edward's. They beat St. Mary's by 14 to close out November, then downed Incarnate Word again last week by a dozen.

ACU has a +12 point scoring margin, averaging 76.4 ppg while giving up 64.4. Three Wildcats average double figures led by Alex Guiton's 18.0 ppg. Over half of her field goals have come from 3-point range, and she has accounted for nearly half the team's 3-pointers. She is shooting 47.4% from behind the arc and 80.9% from the free throw line. Audrey Maxwell averages 14.5 ppg and leads the team in rebounding at 8.4 rpg. Kristee Davidson adds 10.0 ppg. Guiton, Maxwell, and Davidson have started all 10 games this season, as have Ashlee Barr and Lacey Blau.

Streaks: The teams have met just once in their history. The Yellowjackets downed the Wildcats at last year's Chinook Wireless/Holiday Inn Yellowjacket Classic in Billings.

#### Missouri Southern State University

The Lions enter the week with an unblemished 7-0 record. Their season-opener against Northeastern State was the only game they won by fewer than 14 points, and they have an impressive average margin of victory of 20.1 points. The only thing that has stopped the Lions so far this season was the early December storm that swept through the Midwest, causing the cancellation of their home game with St. Edward's. It's likely that they'll run up another big win before they meet the Yellowjackets on Wednesday. The Lions face Hawaii Pacific, a first year program without a win, in their first game of the Hoop-n-Surf Classic on Tuesday. That will be the Lions' first game this season away from Joplin, MO.

The Lions have used just eight players this season, and just seven of those have seen action in all seven games. Despite the limited roster, no player averages over 33 minutes a game and five players average at least 9.9 ppg. Dana-Mae Robbs leads the way at 15.7 ppg. The 6'0" senior is shooting 53.6% from the field and leads the team in rebounding at 8.3 rpg. Tynesha Pierce, a 6'0" junior, averages 14.7 ppg and has 14 blocked shots. Robin Kantin and Danielle DeVader average 13.3 and 12.0 ppg respectively. Ashley Birtch adds 9.9 ppg and 7.1 rpg off the bench.

#### The Week in Review

All three starting guards scored in double figures to lead MSUB to a 69-63 win over visiting University of Mary on Friday. The win was the third in a row for the Yellowjackets, who improved to 5-3. The Yellowjackets outscored the Marauders 12-2 in the final four and a half minutes of the first half to go to the locker room with a 31-29 edge. Alira Carpenter scored 18 of the Jackets' first half points. The Yellowjackets tightened up the perimeter defense in the second half, limiting the Marauders to just one 3-pointer in the second half. After Mary tied the game twice in the first minute of the second half, the Jackets pulled away and never trailed again. Their largest lead of the half was 10 with 15 minutes to play.

Carpenter scored a game-high 24 points on 8-of-13 shooting from the field. She was 4-of-5 from 3-point range, hitting all four of her long range attempts in the first half. Backcourt mates Shantell Marquis and Jetton Meadors scored 13 and 11 respectively. The 13 points were a career high for Marquis. She also had a team-high six rebounds. Michelle Lieber was held to just five points on six free throw attempts. She was held without a field goal for just the third time in her career at MSUB, but she added two blocks and a career-high four steals on the defensive end. Dani Henderson added seven points and five rebounds. The freshman also had a career-high three assists. Jen Smith chipped in seven points off the bench.

This week marks the end of the non-conference season for the Yellowjackets, with two tough in-region games on the schedule. MSUB is currently 4-1 at home and 1-2 away from Alterowitz. It will take two good performances this week to improve on that road record with their two opponents entering the week a combined 15-2....Coach Kevin Woodin can't be accused of dodging tough games. The three teams that have beaten the Jackets so far are a combined 29-1, with North Dakota currently ranked 4th in the country and Missouri Western ranked 14th. Missouri Western recently knocked off top-ranked Emporia State. Woodin's goal in scheduling tough non-conference games is to be prepared for the conference schedule, which starts December 30 in Billings against the team that knocked the Jackets out of last year's Heartland Conference playoffs, Oklahoma Panhandle State....The 69 points scored by the Jackets in the win over Mary last week were the fewest MSUB has scored in any win this season. In 18 wins last season they scored fewer than 70 points just four times....It was apparent in the preseason that freshman guard Shantell Marquis was going to be an impact player. An athletic defender that leads the team in steals, Marquis has added some offensive punch to her game the last couple weeks. She has recorded season highs for scoring in each of the last two games....There aren't going to be any scouting reports this season that don't have Alira Carpenter (17.4 ppg) and Michelle Lieber (14.9 ppg) at the top of the "must stop" list. But the Jackets have been getting scoring from other areas. Currently five other players average between six and 10 points a game....There have been 23 players in school history score over 800 career points. Look for Michelle Lieber to make it 24 this week. She needs 12 points to reach 800 and 109 points to break into the top 20 in school history.
