Texas A&M University-International

The Dustdevils won their first three games of the season but have lost six-straight and will come to Billings with a 3-6 overall record. In its first year of NCAA provisional membership, Texas A&M-International will count as a non-NCAA opponent for the Yellowjackets this season. Along with Newman and Texas-Permian Basin, TAMUI will become members of the Heartland Conference when MSUB moves to the GNAC next year.

Despite their record, the Dustdevils average 66 points a game while allowing 65. Their average scoring margin was helped by a 96-50 season-opening win against Universidad Regiomontana. Vanessa Villareal, a 5'10" senior, is the offensive leader. She averages 22 points a game and has gone for over 20 points in six games, including a 40-point barrage in the win against UR. Jermina Tomlison, a 5'6" senior, averages 18 points a team-best 9.5 rebounds a game. Villareal and Tomlison have scored more points than the rest of the Dustdevils combined.

St. Edward's University

The Hilltoppers advanced to the Heartland Conference championship game last year and were picked to finish third in the conference this season. They have started the season 1-9 with their lone win coming in early December against East Central (OK). The Hilltoppers play at Lincoln on Wednesday before making the trip to Billings for a Saturday-Sunday series.

The Hilltoppers don't have a player averaging double figures. Whitney Regian, a 5'7" transfer from TCU, averages 7.6 points a game. Four other players average at least five points a game. Tammy Bartosh and Sara Head each average five rebounds a game. Bartosh averaged 9.7 ppg in three games against the Jackets last year.

The Week in Review

Coming off two big wins in Hawaii, the Lady Jackets continued their roll, cruising to an 80-64 win over visiting Oklahoma Panhandle State on Saturday to put a bow on 2006. The contest was the first Heartland Conference match-up for both teams this season. The Lady Jackets built a double-digit lead by the five minute mark of the first half on back-to-back threes by Kayla McPherson. The Aggies could get no closer than 22 points after the Jackets were up by as many as 35.

The balanced effort of Michelle Lieber in the paint and Alira Carpenter's hot shooting from 3-point range lifted the Jackets to 1-0 in league play and 8-3 overall. Shantell Marquis continued to shine defensively picking up three steals. Carpenter scored a game-high 26 points on a school-record seven 3-pointers. Lieber finished with 19 points on a perfect 5-of-5 shooting from the field. Marquis added 13 points and a career-high seven assists, and McPherson knocked down four 3-pointers for 12 points.

Tip Ins

The Lady Jackets are looking forward to 2007 for good reason. This young squad continues to put up big numbers. They have score over 75 points eight times and at least 80 points six times....The Yellowjackets recorded their sixth-straight win on Saturday. Seven of the 10 current team members were part of the squad that set a school record with 14 consecutive wins last year....The Jackets' current rate at the free throw line (78.2 percent) would rank first in school history if it held for the entire season....Michelle Lieber needs just two points in Thursday's game against the Dustdevils to move into the No. 21 spot in school history for career points. She currently has 840. To get into the top 20 in school history she'll need to reach 897 points. Only 17 players in school history have ever scored 1,000 points in their careers....Alira Carpenter's seven 3-pointers in the win over OPSU tied the school single game record. Shannon Harvey was the last to make seven in a game in a win over Humboldt State on Dec. 18, 2004. Jenni Winter and Amy Winslow were the first two to accomplish the feat....Carpenter is shooting 50 percent from 3-point range and McPherson is hitting at nearly a 40 percent clip. The school record for single season 3-point percentage was Becky Jacobs's 50.0 percent in 2000-2001....McPherson has averaged just 17.7 minutes per game but has come off the bench to hit 23 threes, second on the team to Carpenter. Both players rank in the top five in the Heartland Conference for both 3-point percentage and 3-pointers per game....Carpenter was named the Heartland Conference player of the week for her record-setting performance on Saturday. It is Carpenter's third player of the week award from the conference this season with all three coming in the last four weeks.
