The Week in Review

The Lady Yellowjackets wrapped up their fall practice season with a scrimmage against a team of alumni on Saturday. That scrimmage ended two weeks of two-a-day practice sessions.

The Yellowjackets return a host of veterans in 2006 after graduating just one player from last year's team that finished 11-5-2 overall. The Yellowjackets were picked to finish third in the Heartland Conference in the preseason coaches' poll. Although they'll be tested right out of the gate on an early season road trip, their first shot at a conference foe won't come until September 9 when they play at St. Mary's.

Colorado School of Mines

The Orediggers, from Golden, CO, were a first year program last year. They posted a respectable 7-8 overall record while playing a non-conference schedule. Entering their first season of competition in the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference the Orediggers have been picked to finish sixth in the nine-team league. The Jackets edged CSM 1-0 in overtime in Billings last year.

Fort Lewis

The Skyhawks, from Durango, CO, are picked to finish third in the RMAC west division. They were 13-4-3 overall last season and finished ranked fifth in the NCAA Midwest Region. Senior defender Katrina Kranzler was an all-conference first team and all-region second team selection last year. She is a preseason All-RMAC choice this fall. MSUB is 0-4-1 all time against Fort Lewis with a 1-1 draw last year. The Jackets and Skyhawks will meet in a neutral-site game in Portales, NM.

Eastern New Mexico

The Zias, from Portales, NM, are picked to finish seventh in the 10-team Lone Star Conference. Last season, just the third of the program's history, they posted a 10-8-1 overall record. Senior Megan Dozier was a first team all-conference choice last year. Senior Anna Funck earned all-conference honorable mention honors. The Yellowjackets and Zias have never played.
