#### The Week in Review

The Yellowjackets hosted the fifth annual MSU-Billings Cup on Saturday and Sunday. This year's tournament included University of Texas-Permian Basin, University of Mary, and University of Great Falls. The Jackets opened the Cup with an 11-0 thrashing of Texas-Permian Basin. The Hawks are in the first year of reclassification from NAIA to NCAA Division II to join the Heartland Conference. The Yellowjackets scored 57 seconds into the game and never looked back. The score was 4-0 before the 15 minute mark. Brittney Sandau and Ally Stroup each had hat tricks. Sandau had three assists to go with her three goals. Also scoring in the game were Jelisa Guy, Abby Bennett, Jenny Moellendorf, and Caitlin Differding. Moellendorf and Bennet scored for the first time this season while Differding netted her first collegiate goal. When the dust had settled, the Yellowjackets set single game school records for goals (11) and points (31).

The Yellowjackets faced University of Mary on Sunday in the championship game of the MSU-Billings Cup. The Marauders had beaten Great Falls on Saturday, 1-0. The Jackets' swarming defense allowed just two shots on goal and five total shots for a 2-0 victory to win their own tournament for the third time in five years. Stroup and Guy each scored a goal, and Sandau had another assist.

## This Week's Opponents

#### St. Mary's University

The Rattlers were picked to finish second in the Heartland Conference coaches' preseason poll after going 13-6-1 last year. They are off to a 1-0 start after a 3-0 win against Texas Woman's to open the season on August 25. Three different players scored for the Rattlers, including 2004 HLC player of the year Kyle Hyslop. Elizabeth Hoffman assisted on two of the three goals. STMU will play a very tough Regis team on September 4 before hosting the Yellowjackets on the 9th. STMU and MSUB split two games last year with the Jackets winning 1-0 in Billings and the Rattlers winning 1-0 in the first round of the Heartland Conference tournament. St. Mary's reached the Heartland Conference title match last year where they lost to Incarnate Word.

#### Texas A&M University-International

The Dustdevils are new to NCAA II and the Heartland Conference this year as they begin reclassification from NAIA. They were out-shot 30-5 in a season-opening 5-1 loss to Texas Women's on August 30. Sophomore Stephanie Webb scored their only goal. TAMUI will host Monterrey Tech on September 9 before playing the Jackets on September 10.

#### University of the Incarnate Word

The Cardinals are the team to beat in the Heartland Conference. They are the defending conference champions and odds-on favorite to claim the crown in 2006. Last year Incarnate Word qualified for the NCAA Tournament with a 14-3-3 record. The Cardinals enter this week at 2-0-1 with victories over Texas-Permian Basin and Texas Woman's. The Cards earned a 1-1 draw with Regis last weekend. Amber Cole has scored two of the Cardinals' six goals. UIW will have a busy week before squaring off against the Yellowjackets. Between September 5 and 10 they will face Texas A&M-Commerce, West Texas A&M, and Angelo State. Both Texas A&M-Commerce and West Texas A&M were top 10 teams in the region last year.

#### **Corner Kicks**

By going 2-0 last weekend, the Yellowjackets reached the best five-game start in school history at 5-0-0. In 2004 they were 4-0-1 to start the year. With three road games coming up, can they match the best eight-game start in school history? That too came in the 2004 season when MSUB started the year 6-1-1....The MSU-Billings Cup victory marked the third time the Yellowjackets have won their own tournament in its five-year existence. They also won it in 2003 and 2005. Metro State (2002) and North Dakota (2004) have been the other two winners of the tourney....Senior Ally Stroup was named the tournament MVP after scoring four goals and an assist in the two wins. She became just the third player in school history to record a hat trick when she scored three-straight goals in a span of eight minutes in the win against UTPB....Stroup's goal in Sunday's win against Mary tied her with Abby Farmer for the all-time school record at 31. Her next goal will giver her sole possession of the career records for goals, assists, and points....Junior Brittney Sandau had an equally impressive weekend. She recorded the fourth hat trick in school history against UTPB. She also had three assists in that game, setting a new school record for points in a game with nine. If that weren't enough, Sandau scored the second-fastest goal to start a game in school history, finding the net just 57 seconds into the contest. To do one better, she set a school record for consecutive goals by scoring 30 seconds later....With so many offensive records broken last week, it was easy to overlook the MSUB defenders. But consider this twogame stat line: 0 goals, 1 shot on goal, 6 total shots. For the season the Yellowjacket defense has given up just one goal in 459 minutes for a 0.20 GAA....The Heartland Conference named forward Brittney Sandau as its offensive player of the week and defender Samantha Boehm as its defensive player of the week.
