The Week in Review

The Yellowjackets split a pair of games last week, rallying to defeat Rocky Mountain College 3-2 in overtime and succumbing to University of Montana 1-0 in double overtime. The win over Rocky came in thrilling come-from-behind fashion. Following a first half that could go into the books as the most uneventful half of soccer all season, the two teams lit up the scoreboard in the second half. Rocky seized control of play early in the second half and finally broke through with the game's first goal at 60:15. The Bears extended their lead with another goal six minutes later. With the clock winding below 10 minutes to play, the Bears had only to kill the clock for the upset win. But Ally Stroup and Co. found a way, beginning when Stroup hit Sara Gress with a through ball and Gress scored the Jackets' first goal at 81:55. With less than a minute left in regulation, Stroup took a pass from Jelisa Guy and dribbled through the Rocky defense to score with 50 seconds remaining. Amy Stephens provided the difference maker, scoring 2:55 into the first overtime after taking a crossing pass from Abby Bennet.

After narrowly avoiding an upset on Wednesday, the Yellowjackets were gunning for an upset of their own on Friday at University of Montana. Senior goalkeeper Megan Plank played one of her best games of the season to keep the Jackets in the game. She made nine saves, eight in regulation, to keep the game scoreless for over 100 minutes. The Grizzlies finally found the net early in the second overtime. The Jackets were out-shot 16-8 in the game, including 10-2 for shots on goal.

This Week's Opponent

Dallas Baptist University

The Patriots are 6-3-0 overall after splitting two games last week. They defeated Texas-Permian Basin 9-2 on Wednesday before falling to St. Mary's 1-0 on Saturday. They are the second-highest scoring team in the Heartland Conference behind the Yellowjackets, averaging 2.56 goals per game. However, they are fourth in the five-team league for goals against average at 1.14.

Mandy Gomez and Angelica Sandoval lead the Patriots offensively. Gomez ranks fourth in the Heartland with seven goals and also has two assists for 16 points. Sandoval has six goals and ranks fifth in the conference with four assists for 16 points. The pair has accounted for five of the team's six game-winning goals.

Defensively the Patriots' Emily Evans has been in goal in seven games, allowing seven goals in 541 minutes. Her 1.16 goals against average ranks fourth among HLC goalkeepers. Evans is second in the league for saves average at 4.71 per game.

Corner Kicks

The importance of last week's games depends on one's perspective. On one hand the games didn't mean a lot because they were non-conference, non-region, nondivision games. The Jackets played a "down" game against NAIA Rocky Mountain on Wednesday before playing "up" against the University of Montana on Friday. However, despite the fact that neither game is likely to affect postseason opportunities, it's always exciting when the Jackets plays their cross-town rival or when they get the rare shot at the only Division I team in the state....The Yellowjackets have received outstanding play from several players this season, but last week highlighted the importance of two seniors. In Wednesday's win over Rocky, Ally Stroup took over the last 15 minutes of regulation and willed the Jackets to victory. Her goal and assist gave her 104 career points, by far a school record. In Friday's loss, goalkeeper Megan Plank made nine saves to keep the Jackets' upset bid alive against Montana for over 100 minutes. She was peppered from all directions, facing 16 shots, 10 shots on goal and a remarkable 13 corner kicks. Her last save of regulation made her the only Yellowjacket goalkeeper in school history with 300 career saves....MSU-Billings made its debut in the NSCAA national poll last week. They slipped from No. 18 to No. 19 this week but remained ranked third in the Midwest Region in the coaches' poll....The first poll that means anything will be released by the NCAA on October 4. That's when the NCAA Women's Soccer Committee will release the first of four regional polls. The final NCAA regional poll on October 30 will determine the qualifiers for the NCAA Tournament....The Jackets' 10-1-0 record is easily the best start in school history, but the next five weeks could determine the success of their season. During that stretch they will play five games against teams that are currently regionally ranked by the NSCAA, including Metro State, the second-ranked team in the country.
