#### The Week in Review

The Yellowjackets dropped both their games last week, falling first to Metro State 5-0 and then in a heartbreaker against Regis University 1-0. The much anticipated match up between Metro State and MSUB began as an evenly matched affair with both teams struggling offensively. Metro finally broke the scoreless tie on a penalty kick, then added a second goal just before halftime. The Roadrunner scoring continued in the second half and the Yellowjackets couldn't overcome the a 16-5 shot deficit. The victory extended Metro's home unbeaten streak to 57 games.

A late goal in the 82nd minute gave Regis University a 1-0 upset against the Yellowjackets on Sunday. The goal came off of a header from a corner kick and Regis was able to hold off the Jackets for the remainder of the contest. The teams battled defensively for the entire game keeping the shots on goal to a combined six. Jacket goaltender Megan Plank made five saves and Brittney Sandau's three shots all resulted in saves. The loss dropped the Jackets to 11-3-0, with all the team's losses coming in the last four games.

#### **This Week's Opponent**

#### St. Mary's University Rattlers

The Rattlers are 7-3-3 overall and have won five of their last six contests. Their most recent victory came Sunday as they defeated the University of the Incarnate Word 2-1.

Goaltender Lily Cano anchors the team, posting a 0.95 goals against average, which ranks third in the conference. Cano has also notched five shutouts, second only to MSUB's Megan Plank's eight.

Offensively, St. Mary's has managed 1.38 goals per game. Kyle Hyslop has provided much of the scoring for the Rattlers with a teamleading six goals this season. Margaret Kaderli has added four goals and Erin McCutcheon has handed out four assists.

#### University of the Incarnate Word Cardinals

Incarnate Word is coming off consecutive losses to St. Edward's and St. Mary's, dropping their record to 6-7-1. Sarah Graef's 10 goals leads the Cardinals in scoring and she currently sits second in the conference, four behind MSUB's Ally Stroup. Graef's team-best .385 shot percentage has been aided by Shamsi Arian's four assists.

The Cardinals have given up the most goals in the Heartland this season. Goaltender Amy Menagaz has been tested thus far and her .724 save percentage ranks her last in the conference.

#### **Corner Kicks**

Last week's losses to Metro State and Regis University marked the first time the women's soccer team has lost consecutive games since September of 2004. Also, for the first time all season, the Jackets aren't leading the conference standings. St. Edward's managed to slip by and now has a one-game edge in overall record ....The Jackets are looking to bounce back this week, and despite any recent struggles, the Jackets are experiencing a record-breaking season. With nearly every goal, assist, and point record already surpassed or likely to be passed, the upcoming games are sure to solidify this team's place in MSUB history. With one more win, goalkeeper Megan Plank will tie her own school record for most wins in a season (12) which she set in 2004. If Plank can also keep her current pace, she will break another of her own records which she set last year. With six games to play in the regular season, her .76 goals against average is well below last season's .91...The next Yellowjacket win will tie the school record for team wins in a season, set in 2004. The team has already set records for most consecutive wins (10), consecutive road victories (6), consecutive shutouts (5), largest margin of victory (17), and many more...Over the past three seasons, coach Don Trentham's .721 winning percentage as head coach has turned the women's soccer program into a true conference leader and national threat. The Jackets were ranked 8th nationally last week before running into No. 9 Metro State. Metro has since moved into 7th in the nation while the Jackets' two losses dropped them out of the NSCAA's national rankings. Metro State also took over the No. 1 ranking in the Midwest Region in both the official NCAA poll and the NSCAA coaches' poll. The Yellowjackets fell from No. 1 to No. 4 in the NCAA poll and from No. 1 to No. 5 in the coaches' poll. The NCAA regional poll determines the four teams from each region that qualify for the NCAA Tournament.
