Hitter of the Week

Michael Pawelek – St. Mary's university

Senior, OF, San Antonio, Texas

Had his best week as a Rattlers, hitting .600 with five homeruns, 13 RBI and nine runs scored, helping the Rattlers to a four-game sweep of Lincoln University. In Saturday's doubleheader he was retired in each of his two at-bats of the day. But starting with his third at-bat he went on a monster streak. He smacked homeruns in each of his last two at-bats of the first game, and then followed that up with long balls in each of his first three at-bats of the second game. The three homeruns in a single game tied the St. Mary's school record, while the five homeruns in five at-bats is a new school record. His eight RBI in a single game is the second most in school history. He had at least two hits in all four games, including three in the second game of the series, all homeruns, and a career-high eight RBI. For the season Pawelek is now hitting .317 with 12 doubles, a team-high 11 homeruns, 49 RBI, 45 runs scored and a .587 slugging percentage.

Pitcher of the Week

Patrick Colgan – St. Edward's

Junior, LHP, Austin, Texas (Texas State)

Colgan pitched seven innings against Montana State - Billings on Monday. He allowed only four hits and no runs while striking-out six batters. For the season, Colgan remains undefeated with a 12-0 record, leads the pitching staff with an ERA of 2.06 and 81 strike-outs. Colgan has also allowed the least amount of runs, 27
