Lincoln University is coming off a four-game split with rival Heartland Conference opponent Oklahoma Panhandle. The Blue Tigers won a 28-3 barn-burner to close out the series in Goodwell, Oklahoma. The Tigers are 6-20 overall and 3-13 in conference play.

Travis Kay leads the Tigers batting a .351 in 74 at-bats. Kay has produced a team-leading 18 runs off 26 hits and has 10 RBIs. Kay has been resourceful on the base paths also stealing 10-of-10 bases for the Tigers. Phil Widel has 12 runs off 28 hits for a .337 average. Widels leads the team with seven doubles and two home runs.

Adam Patch has posted a 2-3 record on the mound for a 7.75 earned run average. Patch has thrown three complete games and has allowed 29 runs off 43 hits in 33 and two-thirds innings. Matt Rose is 1-2 with a 4.81 ERA. He has pitched 24 and one-third innings to lead the Tigers with 19 strikeouts. Rose has given up 18 runs off 30 hits.

As a team, the Blue Tigers are batting .289 and have scored 147 runs to their opponents 199, while the pitching staff has a combined ERA of 8.07.

Week in Review

The Yellowjackets put together another solid week splitting a four-game series against future Great Northwest Athletic opponent Central Washington University. The Jackets dropped the first game 11-1 but bounced back in the late game to win 3-2. Day two saw the Yellowjackets drop the first game of the day 7-4 only to battle back for the 4-2 win to close out the series.

Despite a career-high three stolen bases by Kyle Pryor, he scored the Jackets lone run in game one. The Wildcats' pitcher Travis Bertholf owned the mound allowing the Jackets just two hits in the game. Refocusing for the second game, the Yellowjackets only needed three runs to earn a split on the day. Pryor, Willie Crtalic, and Matt Schoonover scored runs for the Jackets. Crtalic went 2-for-3 in the game with one run and one RBI to lead the Jackets' offense. Brian Strom threw his third complete game of the season in picking up the win. Strom scattered three hits and struck out four.

Day two saw the Yellowjackets fall in the first game 7-4 due to execution errors on the base paths. Steve Scott took the loss for the Jackets as he pitched a career-high six and two-thirds innings in striking out a career-best six batters. The Jackets wrapped up the series on a high-note posting a 4-2 win. The Yellowjackets used two runs in the first and fourth innings to ice the win. Josh Wiley hit a single in the fourth to plate Jordan Shine and Pat Smith for the two-run RBI. Ben Lewerke earned the win pitching six and two-thirds innings. He improved to 4-1 on the season while Mike Cease came in and cleaned up allowing no runs and no hits in the final two outs.

The Yellowjackets remain at .500 on the season to sit fourth in the Heartland Conference standings...Mike Cease was named the HLC Pitcher of the Week for March 5-11 and continues to hold the top spot in the conference with five saves on the season and has a 0.00 ERA in 8.2 innings on the mound...The Jackets have posted a 10-2 record over the last two weeks to make it the best stanza in school history...Kyle Pryor broke the school record for stolen bases in a single game with three against Central Washington...As a team, the Yellowjackets are just two wins shy of tying the number of wins posted for the entire 2006 season.

Chris Brown is entering his second season at the helm of the Yellowjacket baseball program. In his first season, the team went 15-35 overall and 13-27 in the Heartland Conference. Brown was the head coach for two seasons at Bemidji State University, a Division II institution in Bemidji, MN, but left the Beavers immediately to begin recruiting at MSU-Billings. At Bemidji, Brown was the first coach in the program's 54 year history to post back-to-back seasons of more than 10 conference wins. Before he was promoted to head coach in the summer of 2002, Brown was an assistant coach at Bemidji State for two years. As an assistant he served as the team's recruiting coordinator and pitching coach. He spent one season as an assistant coach at Jamestown College (ND), where he was a pitcher for four years.
