### Opponent Information: Lincoln University

The Blue Tigers will march into Billings April 13 and 14 with an 11-28 record. Lincoln is 7-17 in the Heartland Conference and sit fifth, just one spot behind the Yellowjackets. Lincoln and MSUB met for a four-game series in Jefferson City March 23 and 24 that saw the Jackets fall in game one 7-2 only to rebound with three-straight wins against the Tigers. In the two seasons of Yellowjackets baseball, MSUB and Lincoln are knotted at six wins apiece. This weekend's series may, barring a split, put the Jackets firmly into fourth place or could knock them back to fifth in the league.

Lincoln took three of four games against Heartland rival Oklahoma Panhandle over the weekend and are riding their longest winning streak of the season thus far with three games.

The Tigers' Phil Widel is batting .357 turning in 26 runs, seven doubles, a team-leading five home runs, and 23 RBIs. Widel's consistency at the plate has earned him 19 walks. Travis Kay (.330) has also produced 26 runs and has stolen 12 bases off 15 attempts. Tyrell Roseburrow knows how to drop the ball into the pocket hitting a team-leading four triples, and 24 RBIs. Roseburrow's speed is apparent as he has stolen 12-of-13 bases, and has turned in 25 runs for the Blue Tigers.

The duo of Matt Rose and Adam Patch have combined for six of the team's 11 wins on the mound. Rose has an ERA of 4.57. He has allowed 29 runs off 48 hits in 45.1 innings. Rose leads the team with 38 strikeouts and a 3-4 record. Patch (3-5), has given up 43 runs off 76 hits in 54.2 innings, while striking out 21.

As a team, the Tigers are batting .297 and have 47 doubles, 11 triples, and 16 home runs on the season. The pitching staff has a combined 7.32 earned run average to their opponents 5.19 and have struck out 134 batters.

Brown was the head coach for two seasons at Bemidji State University, a Division II institution in Bemidji, MN, but left the Beavers immediately to begin recruiting at MSU-Billings. At Bemidji, Brown was the first coach in the program's 54 year history to post back-to-back seasons of more than 10 conference wins. Before he was promoted to head coach in the summer of 2002, Brown was an assistant coach at Bemidji State for two years. As an assistant he served as the team's recruiting coordinator and pitching coach. He spent one season as an assistant coach at Jamestown College (ND), where he was a pitcher for four years.
