 - Dr. Oravecz: discussed what may or may not be the tuition increase for the next two academic years. Also, similar to last week's discussion with President Dicharry regarding mandatory fees being held flat for the same two years, Dr. Oravecz reiterated this to the Senate. He also indicated that OCHE/Board of Regents would entertain the consideration to raise a particular, specific fee. Both Missoula and Bozeman are putting forward a request to increase their respective Health Services fee, as well as Northern. After discussion, the Senate approved by majority to support the University moving forward to place the Health Services fee increase for FY18, and FY19 (as presented during Spring 2017 university wide student fee open forums and senate approval) before OCHE/Board of Regents for approval at the May 2017 Board of Regents meeting.
