About Our Camp

The Camp

The MSU Billings soccer players and coaching staff are conducting an overnight camp for boys and girls entering 5th - 12th grades. The camp will be held June 22 - 27 at the MSU Billings campus, Yellowjacket Field and Amend Park.

The camp is designed to take each camper's skills and knowledge of the game to a higher level by focusing on the technical, tactical, physical, and psychological aspects of the game.

Cost (All-inclusive)

- **Resident:** \$380 (\$400 if register after June 13 deadline)
- **Commuter:** \$280 (\$300 if register after June 13 deadline)
- **Team Resident:** \$360 (\$380 if register after June 13 deadline)
- **Team Commuter:** \$260 (\$280 if register after June 13 deadline)

* *To be eligible for a team discount (\$20 per player), 10 or more players should enroll together. All applications must be received in the same envelope. Teams can stay together and train together.*

All meals will be served in MSUB's dining hall, which offers a selection of entrees as well as drinks, fruit, salad and snacks. Each overnight camper will be staying in the dormitories on campus and will receive three meals each day. Commuters will receive lunch and dinner. All campers will also receive a soccer ball and camp t-shirt.

Safety

The safety of the campers is extremely important. In addition to constant supervision from the camp staff on and off the field, a Certified Athletic Trainer will be on staff. Campers must provide their own medical insurance.

What to Bring

Shirts, shorts, shin guards, soccer and tennis shoes, socks, swimsuit, water bottle, a fan, an alarm clock, sunscreen, toiletries & towels, pillow (linens provided), goalkeepers bring gloves

Camp Director



Don Trentham recently completed his fourth year serving as the Montana State University Billings Director of Soccer and his sixth year as the Women's Soccer head coach. Trentham has compiled a record of 53-49-8 and has the most wins of any coach in MSUB soccer history.

Prior to MSU Billings, Trentham served as an assistant women's coach at East Stroudsburg University in Pennsylvania. While at ESU, he gained a Masters degree in Sport Management.

Trentham began his collegiate coaching career at Embry Riddle University in Florida. In his two seasons as assistant men's coach at ERU, he helped lead the Eagles to a Florida Sun Conference championship, two NAIA Region XIV tournament appearances, and a 16th place NAIA national ranking.

Coach Trentham is currently very active in youth soccer, serving as a head coach in the Magic City Soccer Club.

Trentham currently holds a United States Soccer Federation (USSF) "A" and Goalkeeping coaching licenses, as well as a National Soccer Coaches of American Association (NSCAA) Advanced National coaching license.

Assistant Camp Director



Ally Stroup recently completed her first season as the assistant women's coach at MSUB and holds an USSF "C" license. As a player, Stroup was a four year starter, two-time captain and was instrumental in guiding the Yellowjackets to a 13-6-

1 record her senior season. At one point during her senior season, the team was ranked No. 1 in the Midwest Region and ranked nationally in the top 10. Stroup finished her MSU Billings career as the school record holder for career goals, assists, points, game winning goals, and games started.
