This Week's Opponents:

Western New Mexico University – The Mustangs, under first-year coach Brent Hansen, will come to Billings winless on the season at 0-7. Wednesday's game will be their Heartland Conference opener and possibly their final game in Billings. WNMU will jump to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference beginning next season.

Along with replacing the head coach, the Mustangs replaced about half the roster from last year. Leading scorer Tannesia Manley is a junior transfer from Cochise College. She is scoring 14.7 ppg, just less than a quarter of the team's 61.6 ppg. Manley also leads the team in rebounding at 8.9 rpg. Natalie Lara, Sarah Bennetts, and Nicole Ruegsegger each averages around nine points per game.

Streaks: The Jackets have won the last seven meetings. WNMU last defeated the Jackets on January 10, 2004 and last won in Billings on February 1, 1997.

Oklahoma Panhandle State University – The Aggies have sat atop the Heartland Conference standings for over a month after defeating the Yellowjackets on November 28 in Goodwell, OK. The game, which was moved to November to coincide with the Jackets' trip to a tournament in Texas, has been the only conference game played so far this season.

The Aggies will enter the week with a 6-6 overall record. Three players are averaging double figures led by Brandi Lewis's 16.3 ppg. Nina Kuleff and Taneisha Rogers each average 11 ppg and the trio accounts for over 60 percent of the team's 63.5 ppg. Kuleff leads the team in rebounding at 9.8 per game and also has 14 blocked shots.

Last Week's Highlights:

The Lady Jackets haven't played since December 20 when they battled their way to a 65-55 win against Abilene Christian. The win moved MSU-Billings over the .500 mark for the first time since the first game of the season. After winning that opening game, the Jackets lost four straight. They responded with four-straight wins in an unbeaten December to improve to 5-4.

For her performance against Abilene Christian, junior forward Michelle Lieber was named the Heartland Conference player of the week. Lieber's award was the third for the Yellowjackets this season. Tanya Petersen and Alira Carpenter have also been tabbed as conference players of the week.

Lieber scored 14 points on 6-of-9 shooting from the field and 2-of-2 from the free throw line against Abilene. She also grabbed nine rebounds. In her 33 minutes against ACU, Lieber also held the Wildcats' Jamie Boles-Lord to just four points on 1-of-7 shooting from the field. Boles-Lord was the preseason MVP in the LSC South. During the Yellowjackets' current four-game winning streak Lieber is shooting 81 percent from the field.

With her 16 points against Abilene Christian, Tanya Petersen moved up the career scoring list to sixteenth in school history. She passed former teammate Robyn Milne and now has 1,073 career points. The fifteenth spot on the school record list currently belongs to Tami Fleek at 1,129 points. Petersen has also passed the 500 career rebounds milestone with 511. She will likely become just the 10th player in school history with over 1,000 points and 600 rebounds.

Jenny Langford passed her sister Joan (class of 2003) twice in the school record books over the past two weeks. In a win over St. Martin's Jenny eclipsed her sister's mark for made 3-pointers to move up to third all-time in school history. With 11 points against Abilene Christian last week she passed her sister for 27th on the all-time scoring list. With 683 career points, Langford's next basket will catch Jessie Henigman for 26th in school history.

Kevin Woodin (2nd year): Woodin led the Yellowjackets to a 21-7 record and an NCAA Tournament berth in his first season. He was named the NCAA Division II Independent Coach of the Year. Woodin took over at MSU-Billings after a very successful career as the head coach at Billings West High School. He guided the Lady Bears to back-to-back State AA Championships in his final two seasons, including an unbeaten record in 2003-2004. In ten seasons at West High, Woodin was a combined 138-81 for a .610 winning percentage. He was a two-time Montana Coach of the Year. The Libby, Mont., native holds degrees from Carroll College and Seattle Pacific University.

Kami Malnaa (2nd year): Malnaa is in her second year with the Yellowjackets after spending two years as the head coach for Yellowstone Valley Christian Home School. The 2002 MSU-Billings graduate starred for the Lady Yellowjackets for four seasons and is currently ranked 19th in school history for career points scored. She also ranks second all-time with 171 made 3-pointers and helped the Jackets to three NCAA Tournament appearances.

Darryl Helmer (2nd year): Helmer has been a longtime teacher and coach at Billings Skyview High School. He compiled a 108-96 record from 1990 to 1998 as the Falcon's head girls' basketball coach. Helmer guided the Falcons to a runner up finish at the 1996 State AA Tournament and was a two-time Coach of the Year finalist. At Skyview, Helmer produced several college players including former Yellowjacket standouts Shiloh Schwab and Betsy Morrison.
