This Week's Opponent:

St. Edward's University – The Hilltoppers enter the week in second place in the Heartland Conference with a 3-1 record (7-9 overall). They will play a conference game at Lincoln University on Wednesday in which they will be the favorites. If St. Ed's wins at Lincoln Wednesday, it will set up Saturday's game at MSU-Billings as a battle for first place in the league.

The Hilltoppers have won four-straight entering Wednesday night's HLC contest at Lincoln, including three conference counters. That four-game winning streak is a marked turnaround for the Hilltoppers, who lost eight of nine games before starting the four-game winning streak.

St. Ed's enters the week averaging 61.2 points per game while giving up 61.4. Jennifer Knight and Sara Baca each average double figures for the Hilltoppers. Knight, a 5-8 senior, was the Heartland Conference's player of the week last week after scoring 32 in a win against Incarnate Word. Knight averages 16.6 points per game and leads the team with 25 3-pointers. Baca, a 6-0 senior, adds 11.1 points and 4.2 rebounds a game. The Hilltoppers' leading rebounder is Tammy Bartosh, a 5-10 sophomore, who averages 7.1 rebounds and 7.9 points per game.

Last Week's Highlights:

The Lady Jackets had another solid offensive game on Saturday, toppling Lincoln University 78-56 in Jefferson City. The win was the eleventh consecutive victory for the Lady Jackets, tying them for the school record held by the 1990-1991 squad. The Jackets are now 12-4 overall and 5-1 in the Heartland Conference. A win on Saturday against St. Edward's would set a new school record for consecutive victories.

Considering the roll the Lady Jackets have been on, they were caught on their heels a bit as the Blue Tigers kept the game close and even led by as many as two in the first five minutes of play. With 14:47 to go in the half, Shannon Harvey hit from behind the arc giving the Jackets a one point lead. The Lady Jackets held Lincoln scoreless for almost four minutes before the Blue Tigers' leading scorer Sylvia Guldalian made her first of four 3-pointers bringing her team back within one. The two teams traded baskets throughout the remainder of the half. With 2:59 to go, the Lady Jackets gave themselves some comfort room on three 3-pointers by Lisa Jellum, Jenny Langford, and Harvey taking the 36-22 lead into the locker room.

Last Week's Highlights Continued:

"We started slow offensively and missed some early shots," said Lady Jacket head coach Kevin Woodin. "The key to our win I feel was at the end of the first half when we were able to build a double-digit lead."

The Lady Jackets didn't give an inch in the second half, holding the Blue Tigers scoreless for an eight and a half minute stretch. The Jackets' bench saw considerable time in the second half, scoring 28 of the team's total points. A made field goal by Jennifer Skrifvars gave the Jackets a 29-point lead with 13:59 to play.

"The bench deserved playing time," added Woodin. "They always try to increase the lead and make plays happen. They all contributed and earned points, something that is important as the season progresses."

Every Lady Jacket that checked into the game scored. Tanya Petersen led the team with 16 points. Petersen moved up in the school career record book and now holds thirteenth place for career scoring with 1,153 total points. She also grabbed five rebounds, blocked four shots and went 6-of-7 from the field. Michelle Lieber had another solid game posting 12 points and five boards. Harvey also had a record breaking night, moving into seventh in the school record books for career 3-pointers made with 104. She netted nine points on the game, all coming from behind the arc.

"St. Edward's is an important game for us," said Woodin of Saturday's match up with the Hilltoppers. "We are only halfway through the conference schedule so each game is big. Whoever comes out with the win Saturday will hold first place in the Heartland Conference."

Kevin Woodin (2nd year): Woodin led the Yellowjackets to a 21-7 record and an NCAA Tournament berth in his first season. He was named the NCAA Division II Independent Coach of the Year. Woodin took over at MSU-Billings after a very successful career as the head coach at Billings West High School. He guided the Lady Bears to back-to-back State AA Championships in his final two seasons, including an unbeaten record in 2003-2004. In ten seasons at West High, Woodin was a combined 138-81 for a .610 winning percentage. He was a two-time Montana Coach of the Year. The Libby, Mont., native holds degrees from Carroll College and Seattle Pacific University.

Kami Malnaa (2nd year): Malnaa is in her second year with the Yellowjackets after spending two years as the head coach for Yellowstone Valley Christian Home School. The 2002 MSU-Billings graduate starred for the Lady Yellowjackets for four seasons and is currently ranked 19th in school history for career points scored. She also ranks second all-time with 171 made 3-pointers and helped the Jackets to three NCAA Tournament appearances.

Darryl Helmer (2nd year): Helmer has been a longtime teacher and coach at Billings Skyview High School. He compiled a 108-96 record from 1990 to 1998 as the Falcon's head girls' basketball coach. Helmer guided the Falcons to a runner up finish at the 1996 State AA Tournament and was a two-time Coach of the Year finalist. At Skyview, Helmer produced several college players including former Yellowjacket standouts Shiloh Schwab and Betsy Morrison.
