

## **Recruiting at Montana State University Billings**

**Here are some of the reasons your next employee should be an MSU Billings grad:**

### **MSU Billings grads are *educated*.**

The *College of Allied Health Professions* offers 15 degrees to serve regional healthcare needs. The largest and fastest-growing is Health & Human Performance; this year will see the addition of the Bachelor of Science degree in Outdoor Adventure Leadership.

Students in the *College of Arts and Sciences* are now exploring new majors in Criminal Justice and Political Science as well as new Biology options in Medical Lab Science and Environmental Science.

Thirteen students from the *College of Education* were recognized for their outstanding performance on the national ETS PRAXIS II exam in 2006-2007.

97% of Practical Nursing grads in the Class of 2006 at *College of Technology* passed state board exams.

MSU Billings students learn to use digital information resources and to evaluate information they find on the web through the *Library* and its instruction program.

### **MSU Billings grads are *prepared*.**

*College of Business* students placed in the top 20% of all student performance when measured recently by national business simulation student competition and CPA licensing examinations.

More than 115 interns from the *College of Allied Health Professions* spent over 15,500 hours gaining relevant, professional, work experience in 2006-2007.

*College of Arts & Sciences* students have the opportunity to participate in National Institute of Health and Department of Energy funded research projects in science.

*College of Arts & Sciences* and *College of Business* students worked on the "Open Your Eyes" public service marketing campaign that won four Gold Addy awards, a Silver Addy, and a Bronze Addy.

Students at the *College of Technology* are taking advantage of a \$1.1 million upgrade to classroom equipment.

*The College of Business* American Indian Business Leader team won first place in the 2007 National Business Plan competition, Tribal College/University category, in Anaheim, CA.

### **MSU Billings grads are *successful*.**

*College of Arts & Sciences* graduates in the Sciences and in Psychology have been accepted to top medical schools (*e.g.*, Penn State, University of Minnesota, University of Washington) and other professional schools, as well as prestigious graduate programs (*e.g.*, Ph.D. program in Physics, University of Notre Dame, Biology at University of Utah).

Since 2005, 338 graduates of the *College of Technology* were employed in high-demand technology fields like Computer System Technology, Drafting & Design, Fire Science, and Process Plant Technology.

97% of Class of 2006 grads with B.A. and B.S. degrees reported they were employed, attending grad or professional programs, or serving in the military; 74% were in Billings or other MT cities.
