There’s a very narrow window for recruitment, so be prepared. “Make sure you know who’s coming to campus,” says Carol Bergquist, Office Manager of KPMG’s Billings branch and employee of almost thirty years. “Be sure you look professional—collared shirts, nice clothes...(and) keep your résumé short. List your work experience, your extracurricular activities, and most importantly, your GPA!”

The job can be challenging—Bergquist notes the travel requirements are sometimes demanding, as KPMG Billings has clients all over the US—but “KPMG is a great place to build your career, ” Bergquist says. Those looking for positions with this Big Four firm must watch for the on-campus interview schedule and recruitment at the annual Career Fitness Fair in February. Applications outside the October recruitment period will not be accepted.
