

## RECRUITING AT MONTANA STATE UNIVERSITY BILLINGS

**Here are some of the reasons your next employee should be an MSU Billings grad:**

### **MSU Billings grads are *educated*.**

The *College of Allied Health Professions* offers undergraduate and graduate degrees to serve the allied health care needs of our region. Employers hire graduates with skills in Outdoor Adventure Leadership, Athletic Training, Health Administration, or Human Services/Rehabilitation.

Many students in the *College of Arts and Sciences* are now graduating with new majors in Criminal Justice and Political Science as well as new Biology options in Medical Laboratory Science and Environmental Science. Our Medical Laboratory Science Option is preparing Biology graduates for professional licenses in Medical Lab Technology.

MSU Billings students learn to use digital information resources and to evaluate information they find on the web through the *Library* and its instruction program.

Since 2006, 98% of Radiologic Technology grads from the *College of Technology* have passed the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) Certification.

*College of Business* was awarded accreditation by the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB) International in April 2010.

### **MSU Billings grads are *prepared*.**

*College of Business* students placed in the top 20% of all student performance when measured recently by international business simulation student competitions and CPA licensing examinations. The *College of Business* American Indian Business Leader (AIBL) team won first place in the 2007 and 2009 and third place in the 2010 AIBL National Business Plan competition, Tribal College/University category.

*College of Arts & Sciences* students have the opportunity to participate in National Institute of Health and Department of Energy funded research projects in science using state of the art equipment and technology to help prepare for careers in science. All of the College of Arts and Sciences programs are assessment-based. Programs in Art and Music are accredited by the National Association of Schools of Art and Design and the National Association of Schools of Music.

In 2009, a *College of Technology* student finished first in both the automotive service technology and job interview competitions at the State Skills USA Conference and Competition. In both 2009 and 2010, several automotive and diesel students placed among the top three in other competitions at Skills USA.

### **MSU Billings grads are *successful*.**

*College of Arts & Sciences* graduates in all major disciplines go to graduate and professional schools of national reputation. Graduates in the Sciences and in Psychology have been accepted to top medical schools (e.g., Penn State, University of Minnesota, University of Washington), and other professional schools, as well as prestigious graduate programs (e.g. Ph. D. program in Physics, University of Notre Dame; Ph. D. in Biology at University of Utah).
