Internship Basics for Employers

Why Should I Participate in MSUB Internships?

- Interns provide a fresh source of ideas, talent, energy, and enthusiasm.
- Hosting an intern saves on the costs of recruitment and improves personnel selection by using actual on-the-job performance as a basis for permanent hiring decisions.
- Participation in internships builds employers' hiring pool.
- Employers give back to the community while creating a local workforce.

What Are the Requirements to Host an Intern?

- Create a job/project/position description for the student intern.
- Assist the student in developing learning outcomes.
- If a student interns at his/her current place of employment, at least 75% of the internship duties must be new and different from the student's day-to-day duties in his/her current position.
- No more than 20% of the intern's responsibilities may be non-degree related in nature.
- Provide the intern with a copy of office policies, orientation, training and feedback to ensure a successful internship.
- Act as a mentor, provide the intern with feedback, answer questions, allow the intern to attend meetings when possible.
- Participate in a site visit with the student and his/her faculty supervisor.
- Complete a final evaluation.

How Many Hours Do Interns Usually Work?

Students must work 45 hours to receive one academic credit. Most students complete a 3-credit internship.

Paying Interns

MSU Billings sees a number of employers competing for the same pool of interns. The opportunity for exciting work experience and a competitive wage are strong qualities students look for in potential internships. *Employers should pay interns at least minimum wage*. Posting an Internship

- 1. Create an employer profile in CareerLink. (Visit http://www.msubillings.edu/careers/clmenu.htm and click "Employers")
- Select "Job Postings" and go to "+ Add New."
- 3. Post a clear description of the job responsibilities, desired majors, skills, previous experience, and qualifications.



Once you can access your dashboard, you will be able to post internships and jobs. Complete the information fields for the available positions and submit.
